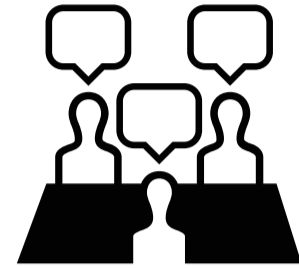


Middelburg

Our team also really focused on the history of Middelburg and The Netherlands as a whole, looking at why our building became historical. We then developed a storyline in addition to our landmark, to help explain our findings in a unique way.
