PREFACE

As part of our research project we conducted research about the chosen design location Tanthof in Delft. Together with five students we did research about several topics like; demography, climate, infrastructure and accessibility. Next to that we did further observations with photo series within the neighbourhood. These were related to topics we found interesting within the neighbourhood of Tanthof.

To get more information about our individual research topics, we conducted a survey within the neighbourhood. From the answers we gathered information which are useful to use within our design.

In this Site Analysis booklet we have visualised our findings. From the survey we drawn conclusions which can be useful for our future design choices for elderly housing. The site right now is occupied by three primary school buildings. Around it there are fences placed for the security of the children.





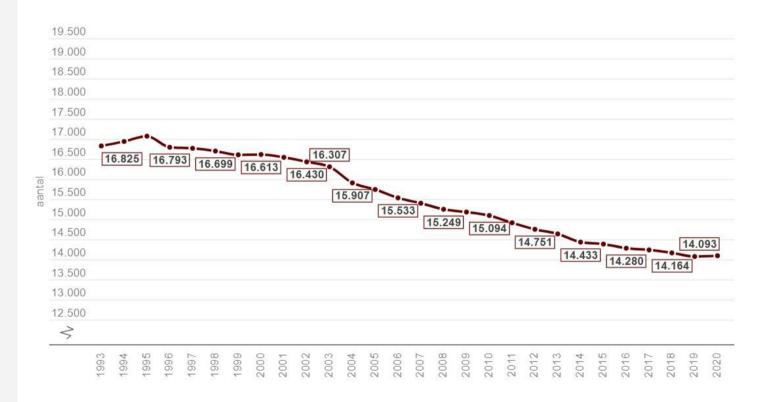






POPULATION

The population of tanthof shows a decrease. From 1993 the number of inhabitants has decreased. This may be due to the aging population, students and starters moving to other cities for study or work.



POPULATION

The graph shows the age development in Tanthof, Delft in the last 10 years.

According to this graph the following changes are remarkable:

- age 0 - 14 : decreases by - 15,6%

- age 15 - 24 : decreases by - 15,6%

- age 25 - 34 : increases by + 20%

- age 35 - 44 : decreases by - 20%

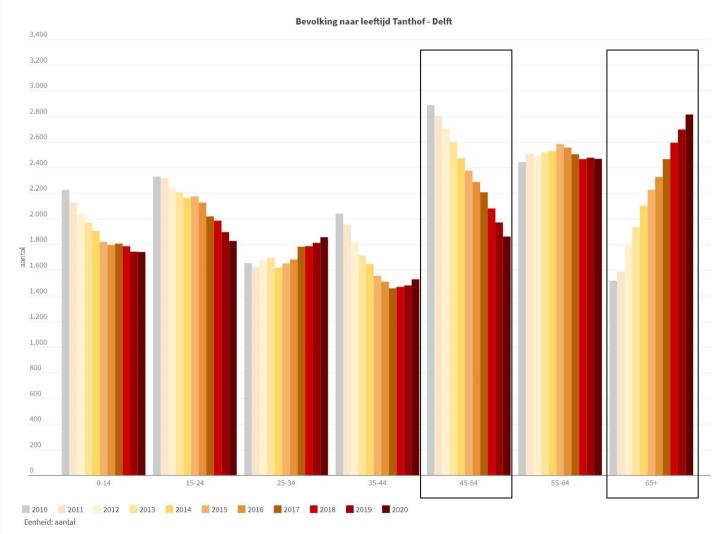
- age 45 - 54 : decreases by - 30,9%

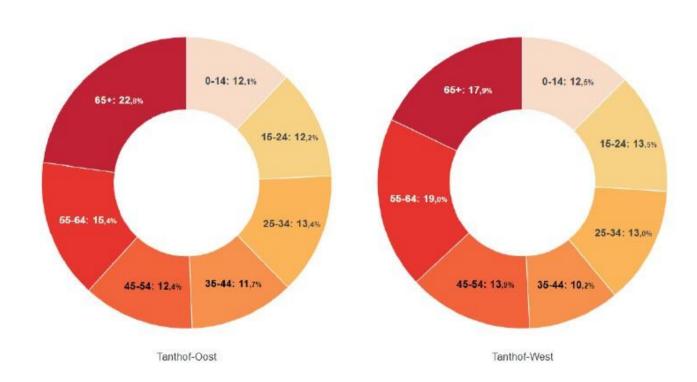

Age division Tanthof, Delft (Gemeente Delft, 2020)



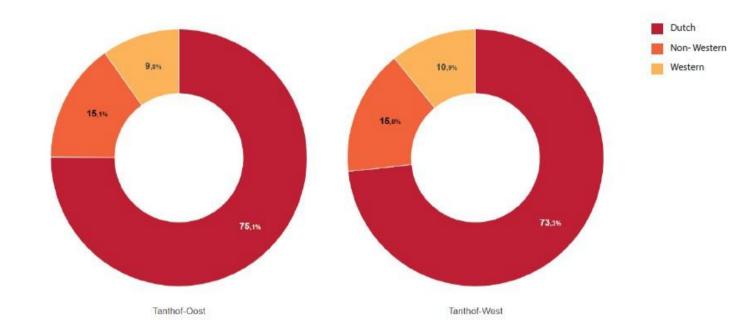
ETHNICITY

Non- Western people (15%): Person with a migration background in one of the countries in Africa, Latin America and Asia (excluding Indonesia and Japan) or Turkey)

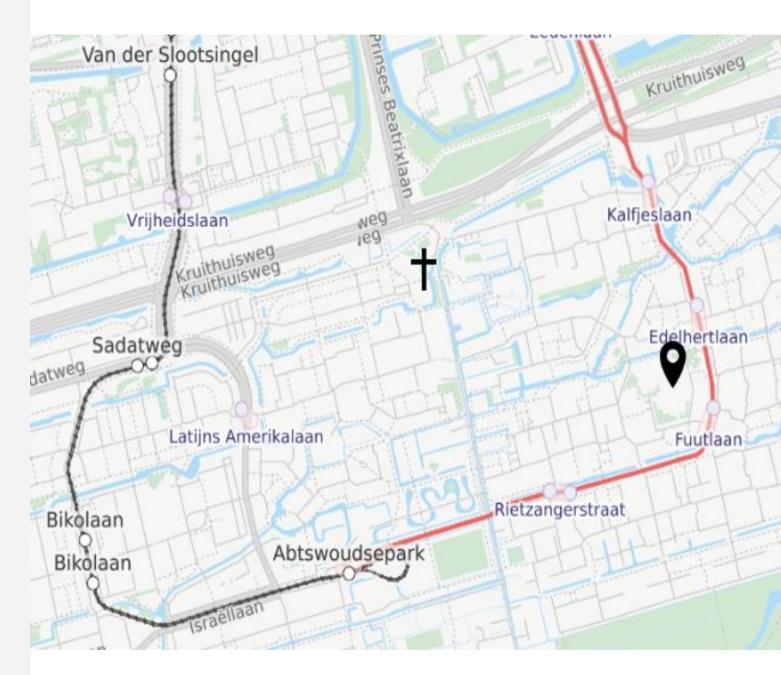
Western people (10%): Person with a migration background in one of the countries in Europe (excluding Turkey), North America and Oceania, and Indonesia and Japan.

Not many religion-related traces are present in Tanthof. There is only one church located on the Abtswoude weg, the Christelijke Gereformeerde Kerk "Het Boek"



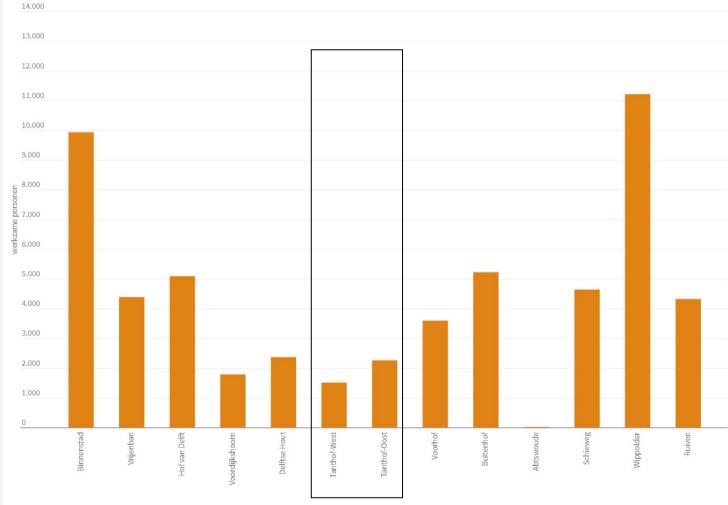
EMPLOYMENT

Both are below average.





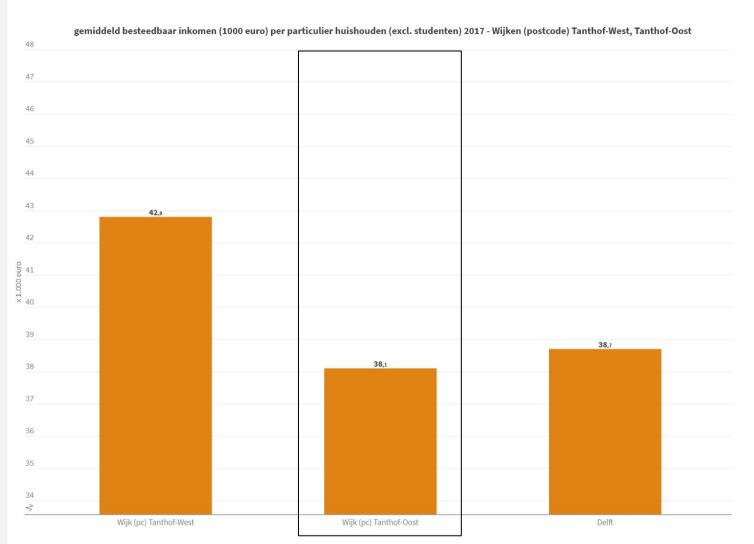

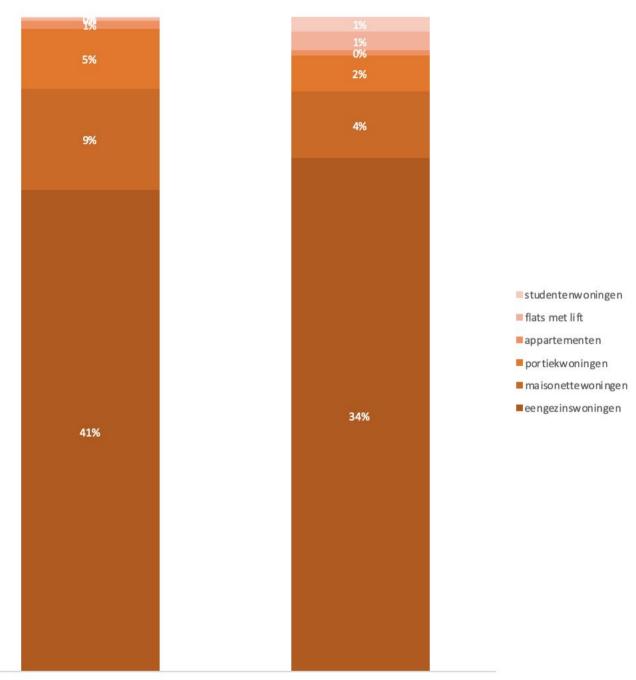

PERCENTAGE DWELLING TYPOLOGIES TANTHOF (GEMEENTE DELFT, 2020)



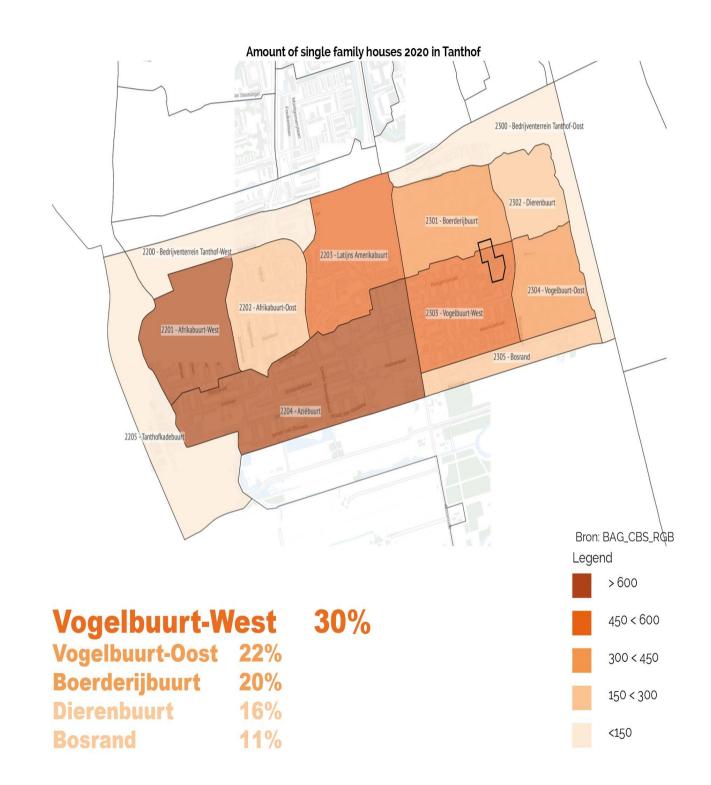

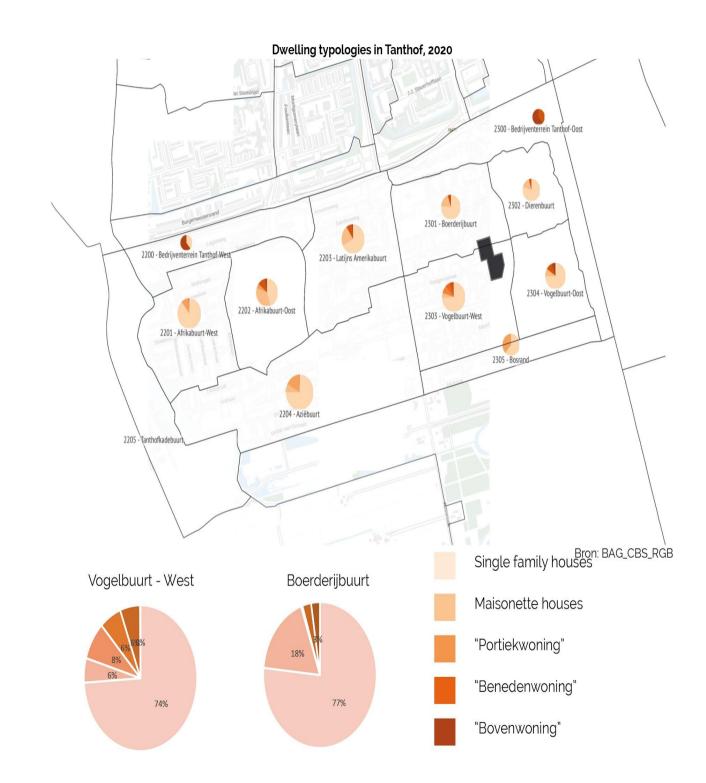
According to the map the most single family houses are located in Tanthof west. In Tanthof east they are located mainly in Vogelbuurt-west which is also where the project location is located.



TYPOLOGIES

Vogelbuurt-west has next to a majority of single family houses a more mixed dwelling typology.

Boerderijbuurt has more maisonnette houses.



SINGLE FAMILY HOUSES

72% of Tanthof east is consisting of single family houses. As seen on the pictures they all have different architecture style varying from flat roofed dwellings to sloping roofs. Most of the single family houses are privately own and therefore often have different colored wooden elements in the facade.

















MAISONNETTE DWELLING

9% of Tanthof east is consisting of maisonnette houses. These are not privately owned. This is visible in the wooden elements of the facade as well as the housing corporation is taking care of the maintenance and therefore the paint jobs.











PORTIEK DWELLING

5% of Tanthof east is consisting of portiek houses. These are also not privately owned. This is visible in the wooden elements of the facade as well as the housing corporation is taking care of the maintenance and therefore the paint jobs.









APARTMENT COMPLEX

Only 3% of Tanthof east is consisting of apartment complexes. These are located on the border of the neighbourhood.





ACCESSIBILITY

As the portiek and maisonnette dwellings are only accessible from the ground floor but also first and second. This result in having stairs throughout the whole neighbourhood which can be an obstacle for elderly.











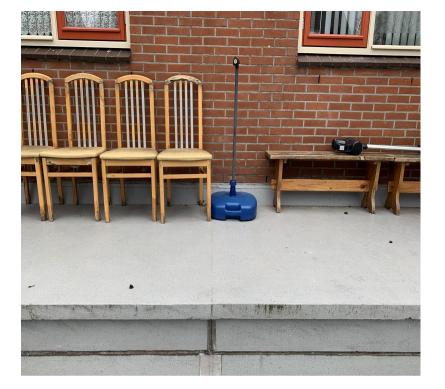






TERRITORIUM OR IDENTITY

Throughout the neighbourhood it was striking that the residents have a lot of value to their private space. A seam on the floor is indicating the neighbours private space. As every resident decorate his private space in a different way this can be elaborated as having their own territorium or a way of identity in the neighbourhood?





COLORS

The use of color is characteristic for the neighbourhood Tanthof. The colors are used in the paintwork of the wood elements in the facade. The different colors also show whenever a house is privately owned or by an corporation. Private owned houses have the authenticity to paint their house however they like.













COLORS GIVES IDENTITY

The use of color can also give identity to a house. Having the choice to paint the facade in the color that you prefer gives a sense of ownership.

BUILDING DATES, 2020

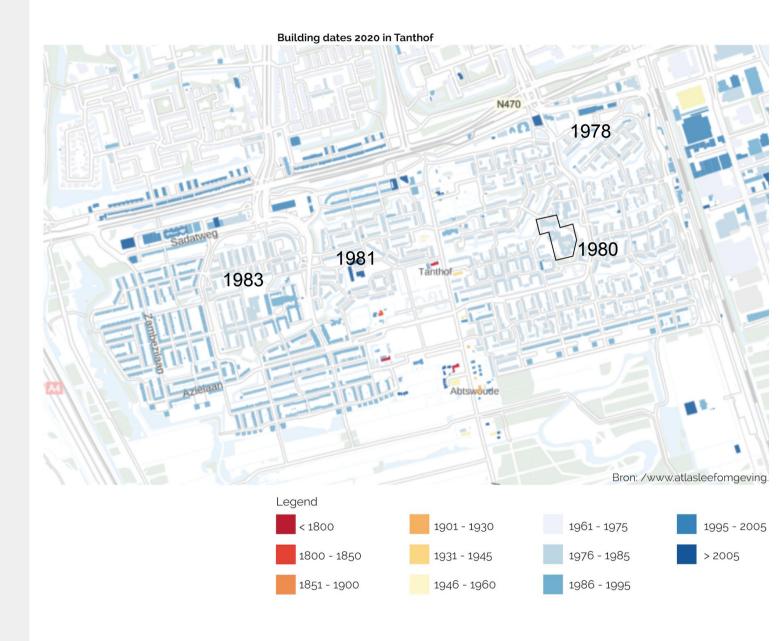
Tanthof is a cauliflower neighbourhood which started building in late '70. Cauliflower neighbourhoods were a reaction to the massive apartment buildings in a rectangular grid. The cauliflower neighbourhoods were built to have cozier and more green neighbourhoods which were suitable for playing children on the streets.

The first dwellings in Tanthof were built in 1978 and expanded over the years filling the whole neighbourhood of Tanthof east and west.



BUILDING DATES, 2020

Tanthof is characterized by a cauliflower structure or "tree structure" the residential areas are "planted" like cauliflower florets on the main roads. With one way and dead end roads making the neighbourhood more fitted for slow traffic.

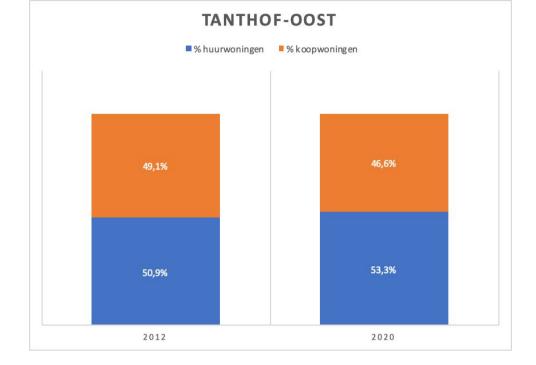


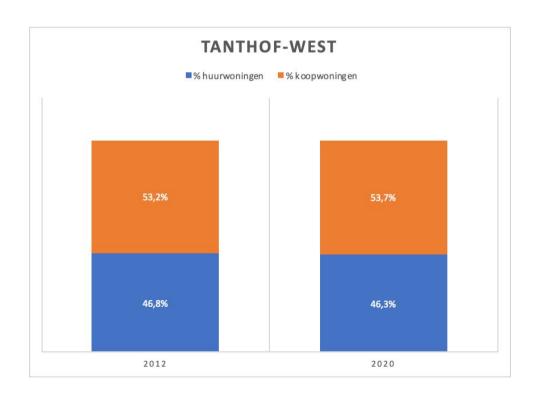

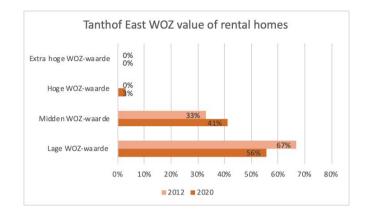

Within the rental sector there was a increase of 8% in the middle WOZ value and decrease with the lower WOZ value compared to 2012.



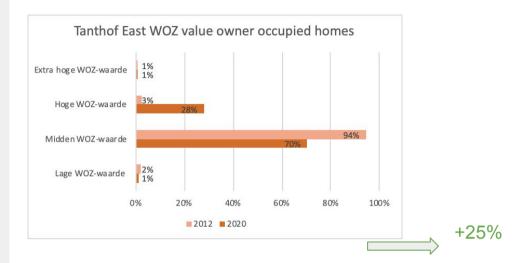

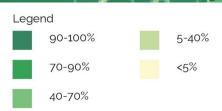


GREENERY

Tanthof, 2020

The area Tanthof and around it has 90-100% greenery. Compared to the rest of Delft, the neighbourhood is quite green. If you look at Buitenhof, the neighbourhood above, it has less green. However, the buildings in Buitenhof are almost all apartment buildings, while Tanthof consists of single-family houses.

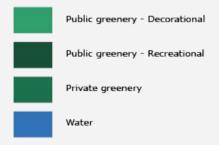




GREENERY

Tanthof, 2020

For the analysis, the greenery is divided into three different sorts of greenery: public greenery - decorational, public greenery - recreational, and private greenery. Besides the greenery, water is important in the neighbourhood.



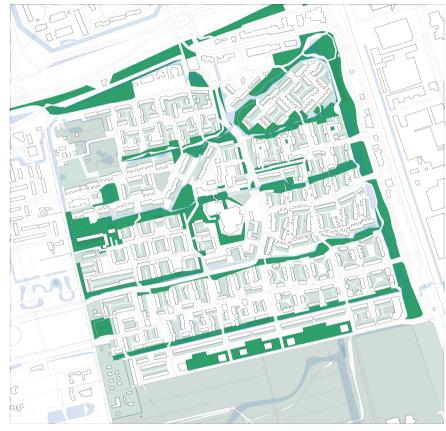

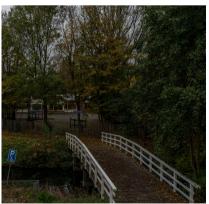
Public greenery - Decorational

The decorational greenery is mostly found next to the water structure in the neighbourhood. The greenery is typical for 'bloemkoolwijken' or cauliflower neighbourhoods. They are there to give a feeling of the countryside or smaller towns within the city. In Tanthof this greenery consists of (dense) trees, shrubbery and grassfields.















GREENERY

Public greenery - Recreational

Next to decorational greenery, Tanthof also made greenery for recreational purposes.

Most of the fields are made for the children, like the petting zoo, football fields and playgrounds, but some are also for all ages. On the south side of Tanthof-East is a forest/park where people can walk and relax. There is also a park in the middle of East and West. On the South-East side, a football club is located.















GREENERY

Private greenery

In the cauliflower neighbourhood, the streets are dominated by cars and pedestrians. The streets are supposed to be the place for social cohesion, but that is not happening. The front side of the houses have small gardens, with most of the time just enough space for a bench, some plants and garbage bins. The buildings are placed to create courtyards between the blocks, so the buildings have larger private back gardens. Some of the houses have gardens next to the water. On the East side of Tanthof there are privately owned neighbourhood gardens. Here people from Tanthof can grow their own fruit and vegetables.















WATER

The people in Tanthof live next to the water. Before 1980, the neighbourhood used to be meadows. The typical polder landscape caused the water structure between the grass fields. In the plans for urban plan of Tanthof, these waterways were kept, so people can live in a calm and peaceful neighbourhood between water and greenery.















CLIMATE

Temperature, wind and rainfall

Just like in the rest of the Netherlands, the average wind direction is coming from the South-West.

The rainfall per month in Delft is a little bit lower than the average in the Netherlands.

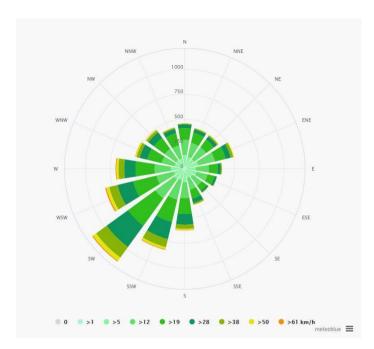

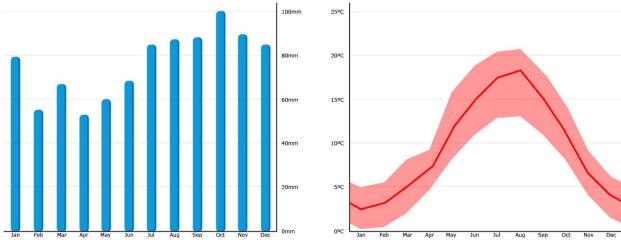

As seen in the map on the right side,
Tanthof does quite well compared to the
centre part of Delft. The greenery and
water help with the lower temperatures.
Next to Tanthof is two very bright red
spots. These are the industrial areas of
Delft. Just above Tanthof are the
neighbourhoods Voorhof and Buitenhof.
These neighbourhoods are greener than
Tanthof and have less heat stress. The
buildings over there are tall apartment
buildings and have a lot of grass fields in
between them. Tanthof is mostly
single-family houses.

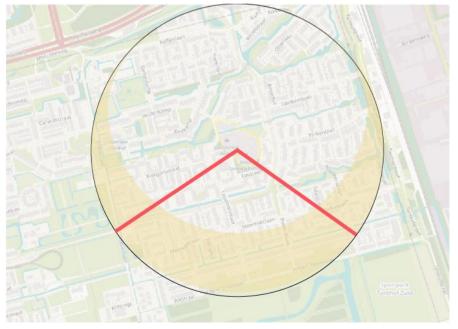

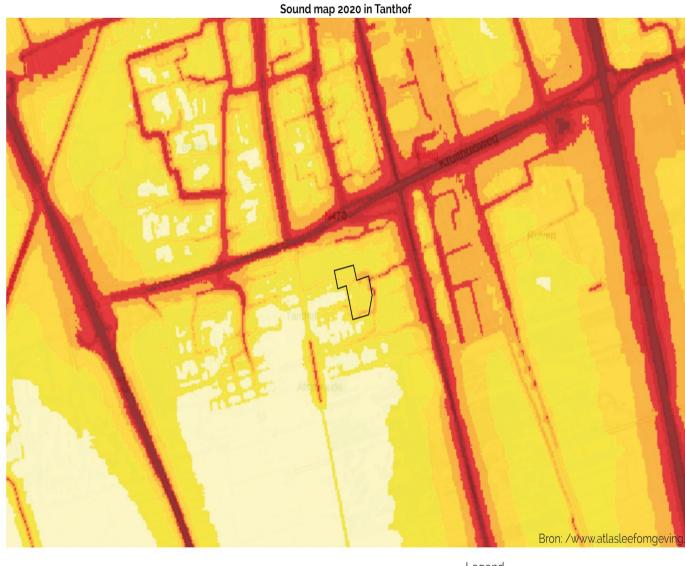

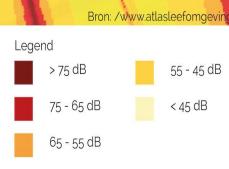
SOUND MAP

Tanthof, 2020

The highway around Tanthof is causing noise pollution in the borders of the neighbourhood. These structures are very typical for a cauliflower neighbourhood. There are larger road around the neighbourhood and only one road that goes into the neighbourhood. For Tanthof-West that is the road on the North and for Tanthof-East that is the road on the East. This is also where the bus rides into the neighbourhood.

The noise in the neighbourhood diminished in the middle of the two side and on the park on the South.

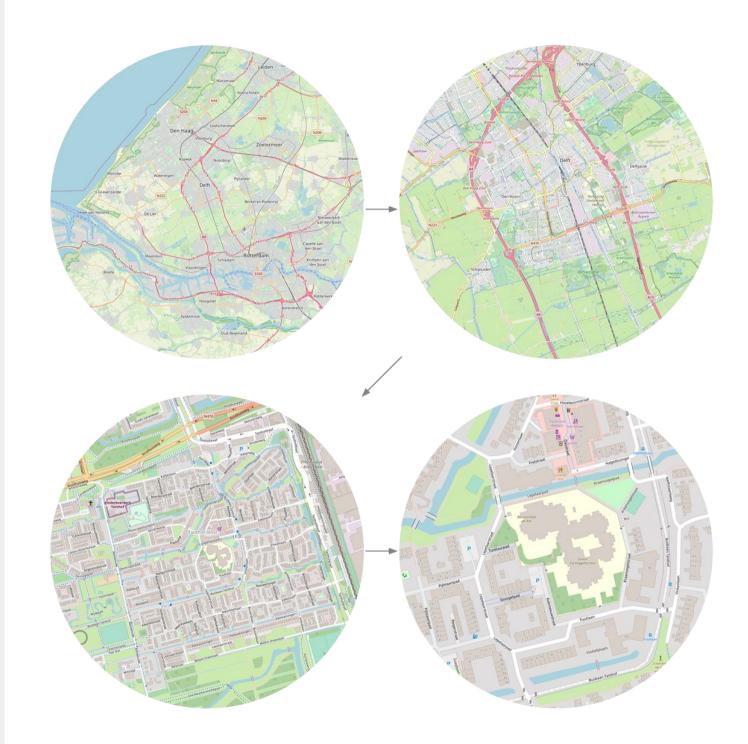

ACCESS ROADS

Access roads for cars. As Tanthof is a cauliflower neighbourhood that was designed for slow traffic the neighbourhood has three main access roads for the car. Tanthof east has only one access road which leads to a very busy road.

Access roads for bikes. . As Tanthof is a cauliflower neighbourhood that was designed for slow traffic the neighbourhood has 13 access roads for the bike.



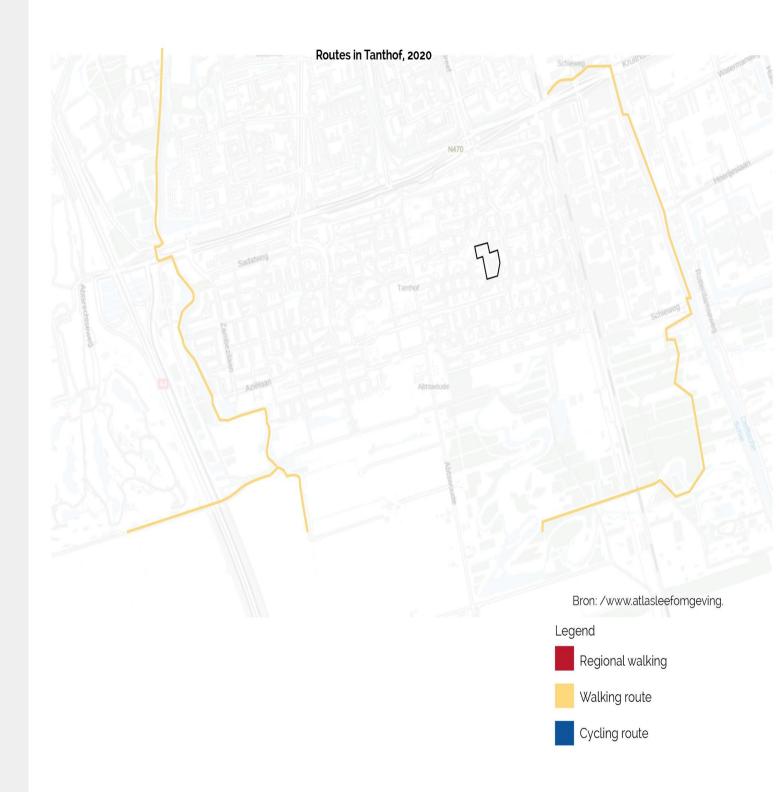
REGIONAL WALKING ROUTE

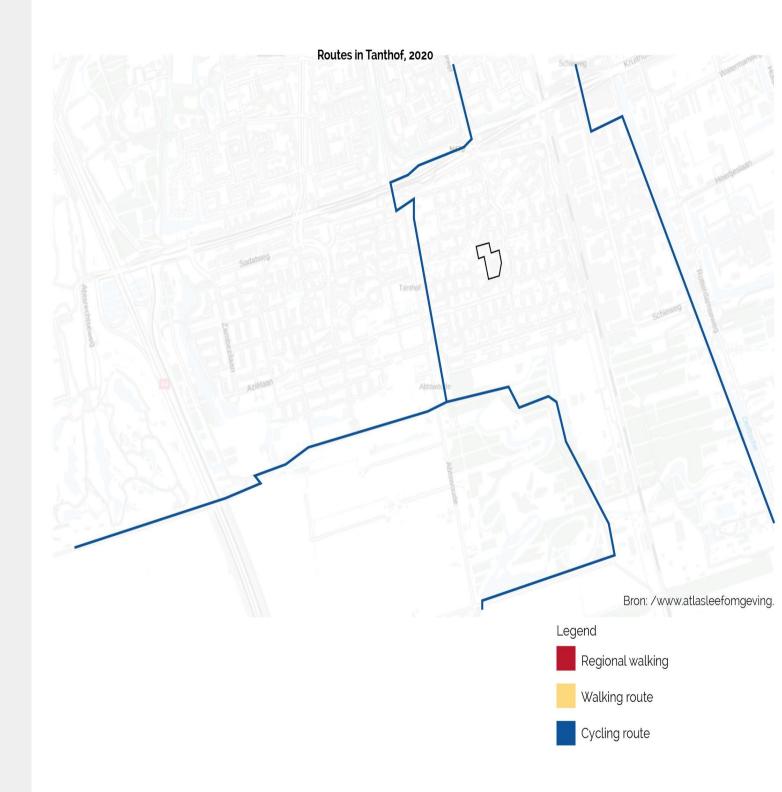

Walkability

The streets of Tanthof Oost are mainly based on the 'woonerven' which are designed for mixed mobility, walking, biking and for cars.

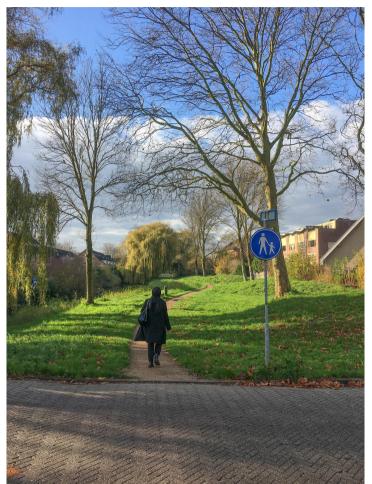
Most of the visited streets are used widely by pedestrians and the cars drive very slowly.

Tanthof Oost also contains a lot of natural walking paths, unpaved roads through natural habitats, they stimulate natural movement walkability.



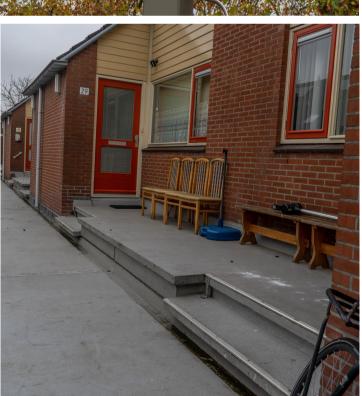

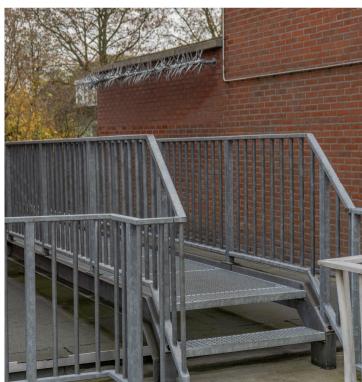
Many dwellings in Tanthof Oost are
Maisonnette dwellings, elevated streets
which provide access to higher up floors.
Though, most of these 'elevated streets'
are only accessible through a staircase.
which is not pleasurable for elderly that are
less mobile.

Also many homes have a higher step, to confine the personal space. Which makes it less accessible for people with a wheelchair or walker.









Obstacles - Stairs

Most of these stairs are often hidden, or on corners of buildings, which gives them an unwelcome feeling, and more designated for the home owners.





Obstacles - Height differences

In Tanthof there are many large trees, of which their roots are often growing out to the pavement, making the tiles elevated. For elderly, this could be an obstacle, a hazard for tripping and less accessible with a wheelchair or walker.







Obstacles - Height differences

There are many collection points for garbage, but they all share the similarity that they are slightly higher from the ground, making them harder to reach for less mobile people.









Obstacles - Bridges

Tanthof is a natural area which also contains a lot of water areas. To cross the water there are many bridges, they are not too highly sloped, so using a walker was observed as easy, but with a wheelchair it is more of an obstacle.



Obstacles - Maneuvres

Many transition zones between faster and slower traffic have certain obstacles to make sure the person is slowed down and ensure a safe environment. But for some cases, the situation is too tight or small to ensure easy accessibility for people with a wheelchair, scootmobile, or a walker.

Social benches

The 'social benches' are located at Dasstraat, the famous shopping centre within Tanthof-Oost. This is a popular place where a lot of residents come and go on a daily basis. The social benches provide a place where residents can sit and have a talk during their grocery shoppings.

The public benches are located on several places within the neighbourhood. Mostly in green areas. They provide a place to sit and have a look at nature and the living environment.

Because it is owned by people, it is less accessible for strangers to sit on.

The residents with a garden have chairs and tables to sit outside. Mostly they are decorated together with plants and objects.























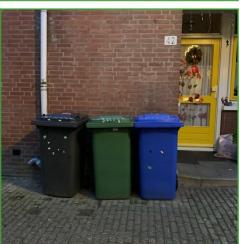












Kliko street

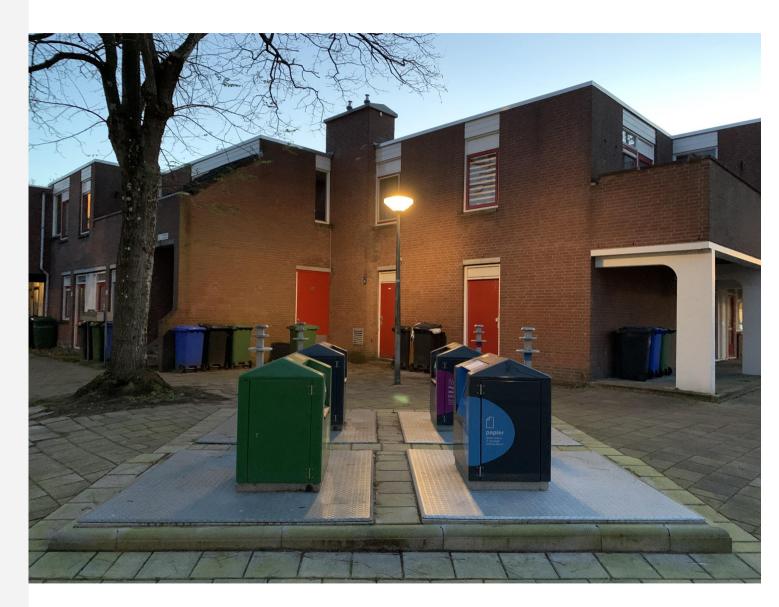

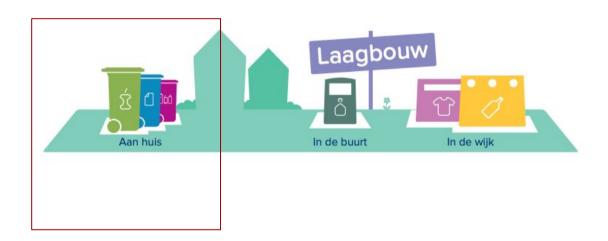

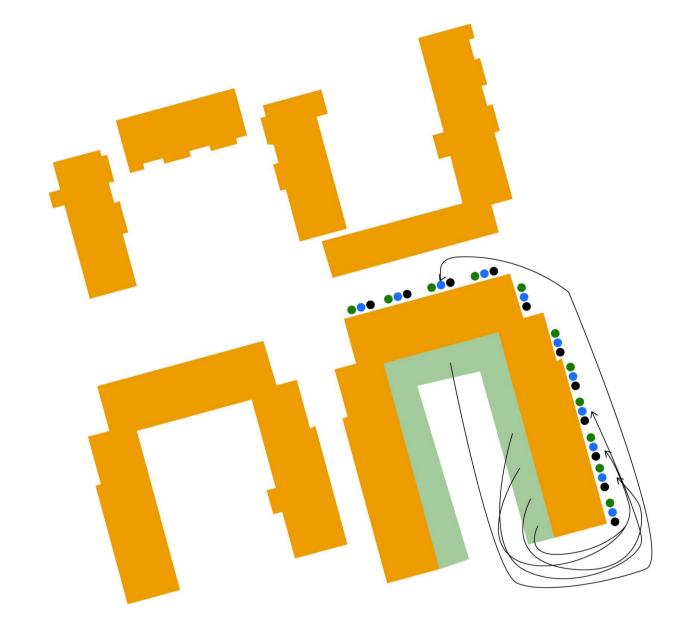


Kliko street

Why are there so many klikos?

Avalex started in 2017 with new way of collecting waste and separating them for recycling.

This changed the streetscape of Tanthof to klikostreets because the residents place them in front of their house due to functionality.





Elderly & Children

The Dasstraat is a very busy and popular meeting point within Tanthof-Oost. A diversity of people and ages are meeting here. Children with elderly (grandparents) pass by. During lunch break of the primary schools, a large amount of children and parents are available around this area. This is also the moment where parents of children are having an encounter.









Young families

Also young families are visible on this location, doing groceries and other daily tasks. Children on bikes and strollers are passing this square.









Adults

Also for students and adults the Dasstraat is a popular place for encounters. They are having small talks here. These encounters takes place spontaneously' and can even last longer than 5 minutes. The group of talking people can get even bigger when an acquaintance is passing by.









Elderly

Also there are a lot of elderly visible on this square. On their own or with their partner, they are doing their groceries, having a walk to other small stores or just passing by.















ENCOUNTERS

Location

The three primary schools are providing encounter moments during afternoon break and pick up times. The merged school building has 3 entrances, where parents / grandparents pick up the students (only for about 30 minutes). The small playground next to the school, where pupils meet up. The largest gathering coming and going around the shopping centre, people talk to each other, while they wait outside, or chat for some minutes. Corona might have even increased that, as people need to wait outside of shops and can talk to other waiting people.





GRAFFITI

Giving identity

Graffiti can mean two things. The first and positive point is that graffiti can be used to create art in the neighbourhood and create an identity. In the case of Tanthof, the shopping centre has multiple shops and streets. The street names are derived from animals, so for example there is the Vossenlaan ('Fox avenue') and they painted the stairwell on that street with a fox. The shutters of the shops are decorated with what makes them special. For example the fast-food restaurant has fries and hamburgers on it, and the Spanish restaurant has a beach with palm trees and a sunset.

Furthermore, the garbage bins are decorated with graffiti to hide the 'ugly' green bins.

All these artworks show the identity of the object behind it.































GRAFFITI

No feeling of belonging

The second meaning of graffiti could be a feeling of not belonging to the neighbourhood. The person who uses the graffiti thinks that the object on which he puts his 'art' does not belong to him. It doesn't feel like he owns it, so he can destroy it.

In Tanthof, the graffiti almost doesn't appear on private houses. The graffiti mostly appears on public buildings, like the gym, electrical boxes, bridges and columns.



































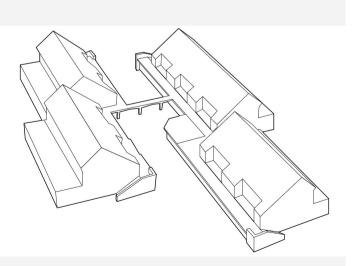


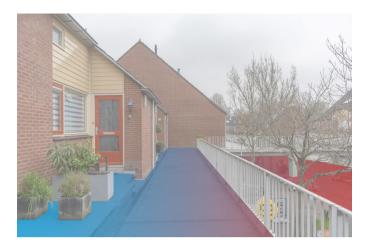
PRIVACY-ZONING

Dasstraat

In the neighbourhood there are different transitions from public to private. For the Dasstraat there is an elevated street, which becomes more private: only for people with a destination. Then the next step is an elevated platform in front of the front door which marks the private zone.

The owners of the house can decorate this area to mark their territory. Most of the residents use benches or plants.



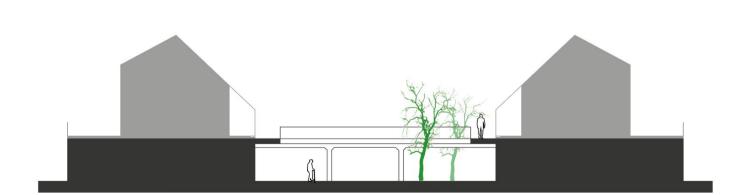

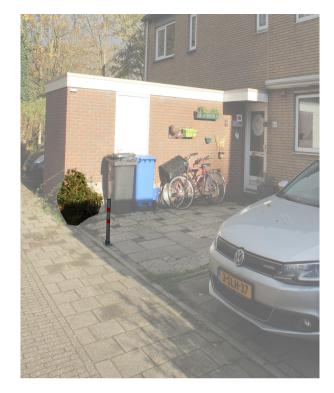
Kraanvogelstraat

In the Kraanvogelstraat the transition from public to private is abrupt. The private zone start at an invisible line: where the street stops and where the storage units start. To clearly mark their private zone, the residents of this house placed a pole in the middle of their parking spot and a bush at the corner of the storage unit. Now no one can park their car in the spot of the residents.



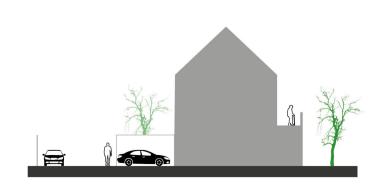

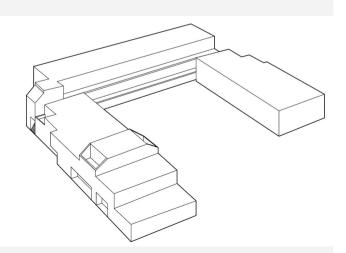


PRIVACY-ZONING

IJsvogelpad

In the IJsvogelpad, the cars are blocked by three concrete poles, so only bikes and pedestrians can enter the street. This already marks a place where not everyone is allowed.

The residents appropriate a part of the street by placing their garbage bins on the edge of the street. The private part is depicted through a slight elevation, plants and benches in the inlet.

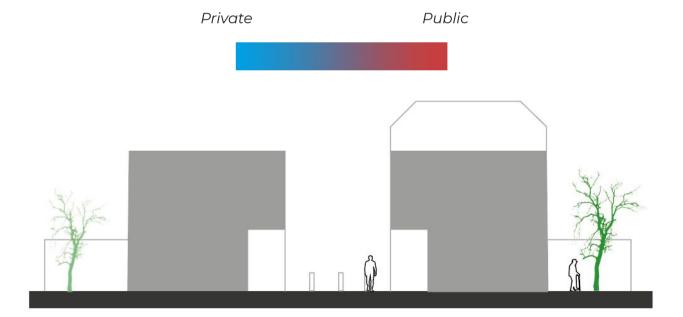

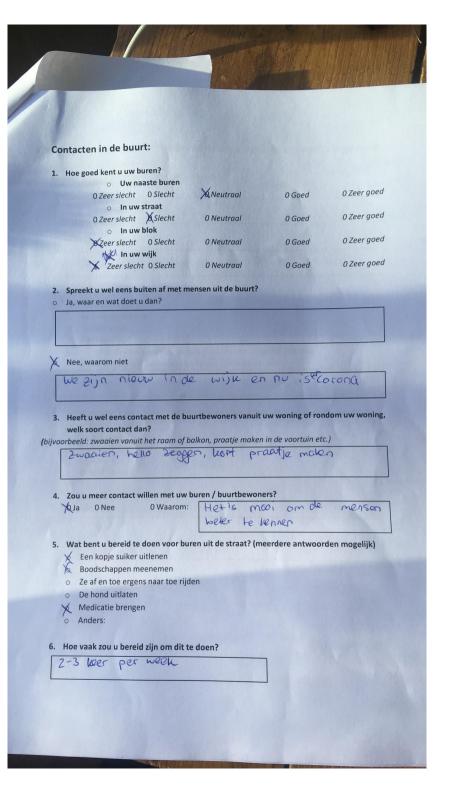

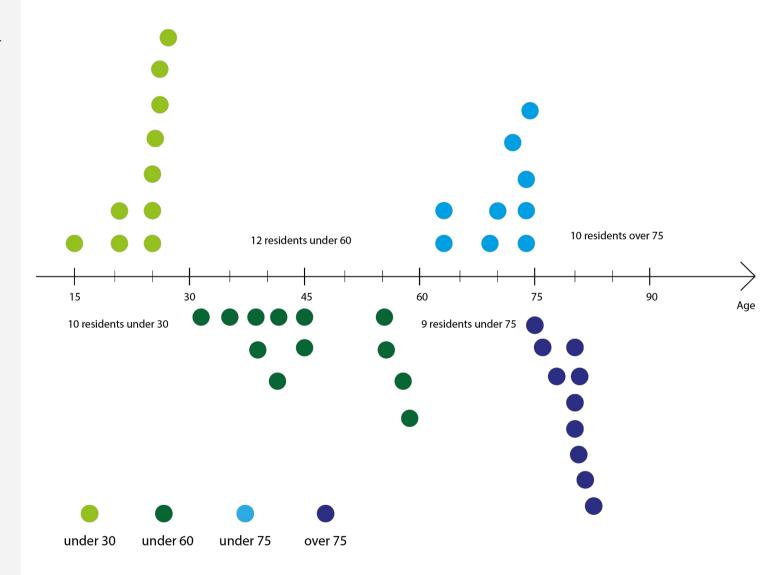




WHO?

Age distribution

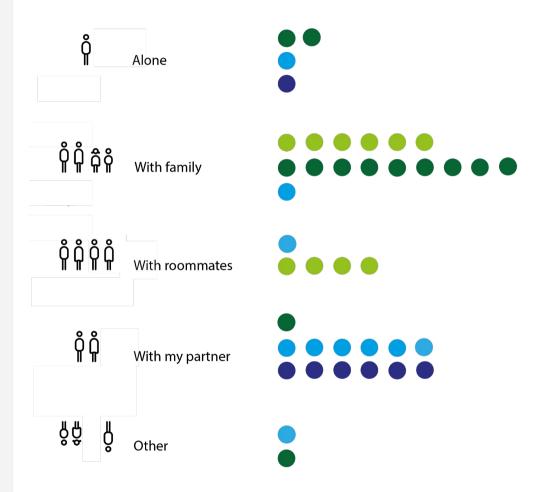
We did not only focus on elderly to answer our survey, but also on young people to get a broader overview. The youngest resident was 15, the oldest was 83 years old.

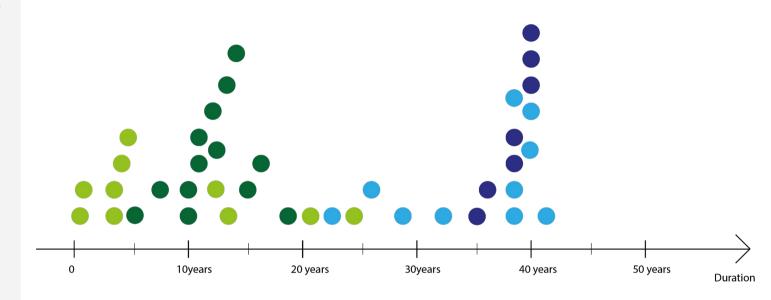

Many elderly have been living in Tanthof about 30 or 40 years, which indicates they like the neighbourhood.

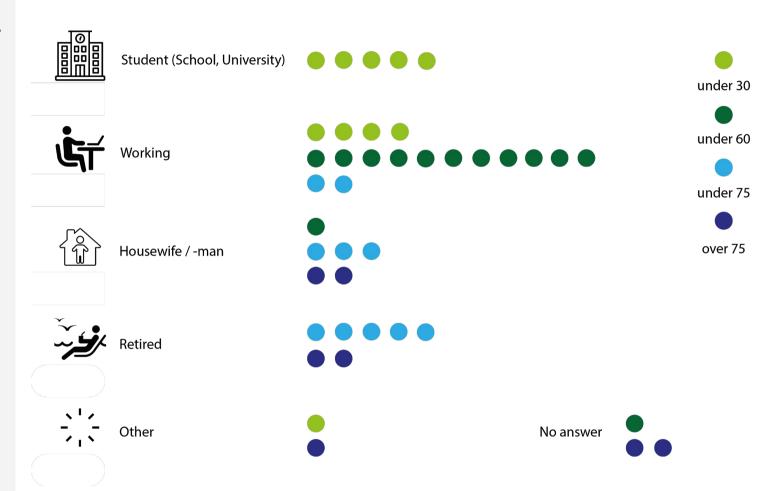




WHAT?

Job/ Occupation

Proportional to the age of the residents they are either in school, are working or are already retired.



WHY?

The residents of Tanthof don't talk about being proud of the neighbourhood. Some even say that they are not proud of it.

The reason that the residents started to live here are for the greenery in the neighbourhood, the calmth, the facilities that are close by and that they were starting to get children. The houses in Tanthof are affordable at the time and they are great in size. The calmth and safety are for them important. The children can roam around freely in the neighbourhood and the parents don't have to watch them all the time.











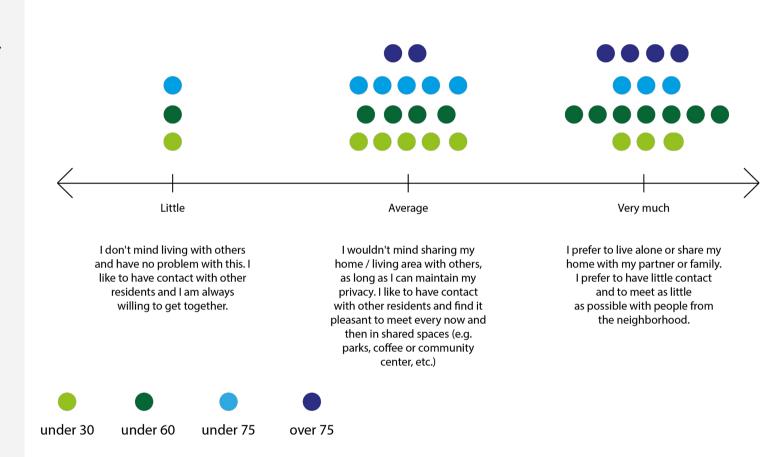


HOW MUCH DO THE RESIDENTS VALUE THEIR PRIVACY?

Value

Most of the residents value their privacy very high and only want to share their home with their direct family. Families with children also value their privacy very high.



PRIVACY

What are you willing to share?

The elderly are less willing to share the

spaces. All of the 75+ residents have said nothing or no answer. Most of the 60-75 years old also said nothing.

The younger people are more willing to share spaces. These people are mostly students and are already known to sharing spaces, while the elderly have already lived 40 years alone with their households.

The bathroom is the least favorite space to share, while a lot of people are willing to share their garden.



HOW IS THE RELATION WITH THE SURROUNDING?

How often are you going outside?

Most of the residents are going outside at least three times a week to multiple times a week. The next few pages will show what reason they are going outside.

Elderly over 75 mentioned going outside for a maximum once a day while younger residents are going more often. As the residents also mentioning the neighbourhood being very walkable, this is also visible in the graph.

Where are you going?

7 out of 10 residents are going outside from 7 to 29 times a week. Under 30 are mainly going outside for groceries, meeting friends, study/work etc. How many times they go outside depends on the activities they have. Residents that are walking the dog are going outside the most. Residents under 30 mentioned they are mainly busy with their social life.

Where are you going?

7 out of 9 residents are going outside 7 to 30 times a week.

Under 60 are mainly going outside for groceries, work and activities for the kids etc. Here again residents that are walking the dog are going outside the most. From the answers it shows how busy their lives are and mainly busy with their kids.

Where are you going?

Almost all "under 75" are going outside daily for groceries, going on a walk, meeting family and sports activities. They are less busy with social life or kids. Their lives are getting smaller.

Where are you going?

Residents over 75 are going outside max. everyday. Their lives get even smaller and the reason to go outside is mainly for groceries. They tend to stay at home more, this could be due to having less reasons to go outside or they can't because they have to take care of their partner.

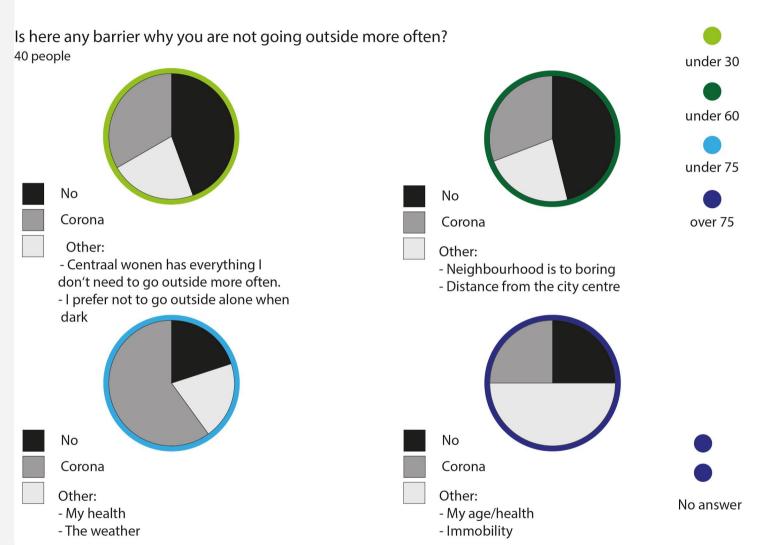

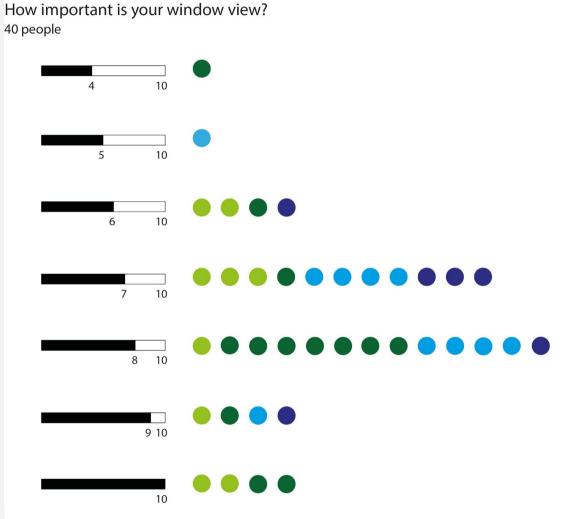
Is there a barrier?

The barriers to go outside more often difference per age group. All ages under 75 often said no or due to corona. Also other reasons were facility, distance or weather related. As people over 75 said age/health and immobility.



VIEW

The importance of the window view show how their relation is from their house and the neighbourhood/street. Most of them valued it at 7 - 8. This can be in relation what their view is from inside and how much they see of the street. The configuration of the houses show different views from their houses such as another house across the street or greenery.

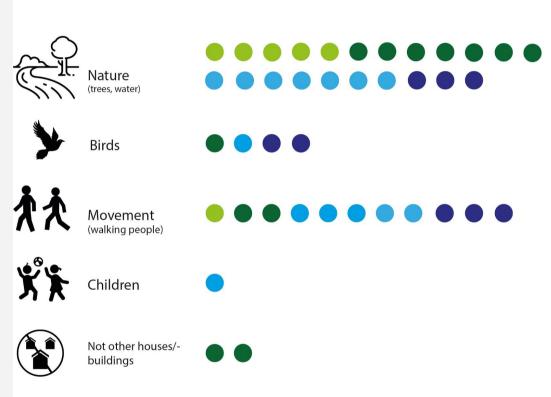

VIEW

This shows what they see from their window view and what they like the most of the view. All of them enjoy the view on the greenery in the neighbourhood and movement of people on the street. Mainly residents above 30 answered this question, which could indicate that youngsters dont value views that much. Elderly above 75 like to look at nature, birds and movement of people. With two remarks: someone said i don't like looking into my neighbours house, because of the dense neighbourhood and configuration of houses you can easily look into other peoples houses. Another remark about the greenery that they value it but it shouldn't be to much.

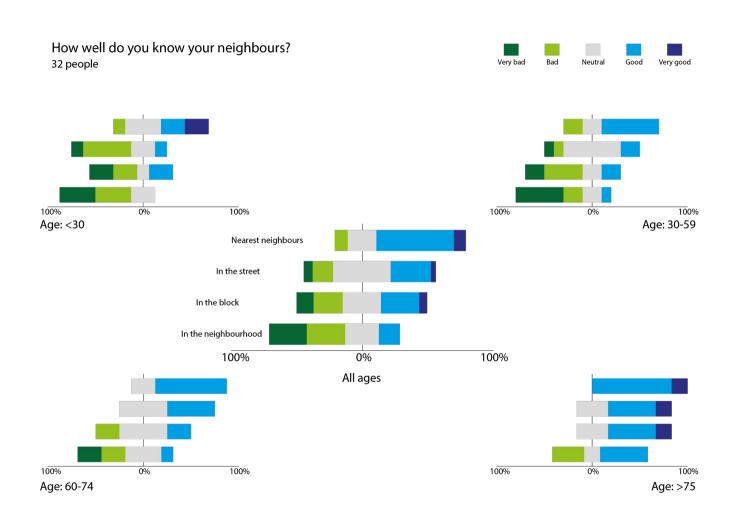


HOW IS THE CONTACT BETWEEN THE RESIDENTS?

SOCIAL CONTACT

In the survey we asked how well the residents know their neighbours. The middle diagram shows the average of all the residents. This diagram is what we thought it would look like. The people know their nearest neighbours the best and they don't know their neighbours in the neighbourhood.

There is a difference between the younger people (top left) and the older residents (bottom right). The residents under 30 vears old know their nearest neighbours the best and don't really know the neighbours in the other scales. The elderly, above 75 years old, know a lot of people in all the scales. Only in the scale of in the neighbourhood they start to say that don't know their neighbours that well. This is probably due to the fact that these people live here from the start of the neighbourhood. The younger people are mostly students and stay here for a few years. They don't feel the need to get to know their neighbourhood.



SOCIAL CONTACT

Meeting outside with neighbors varies by age group. Overall, the distribution appears to be 55%: 45%, but looking at age we see that older people (60+) more often meet outside. This may be because they are more familiar with neighbors and have more free time.

Respondents who answered yes indicated that they did activities such as drinking a cup of coffee, visiting, walking dogs together or playing cards.

Those who answered no indicated that they did not want to meet due to corona, aging, limited circumstances, time and no need for it.

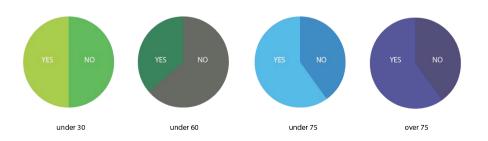
Do you ever meet outside with people from the neighborhood?

SOCIAL CONTACT

Social contact finds place at different levels. Mostly it is on a superficial level, like the handwave, hello and small talks in front of the garden, in the neighbourhood or parking lot. A small group of respondents are having more close contacts with some neighbours they are familiar or friends with, like visiting each other, showing helpfulness and calling each other.

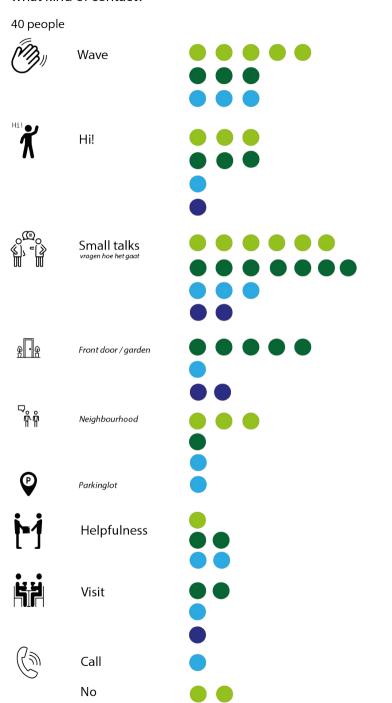
Do you have contact with local residents from your home or around your home, what kind of contact?

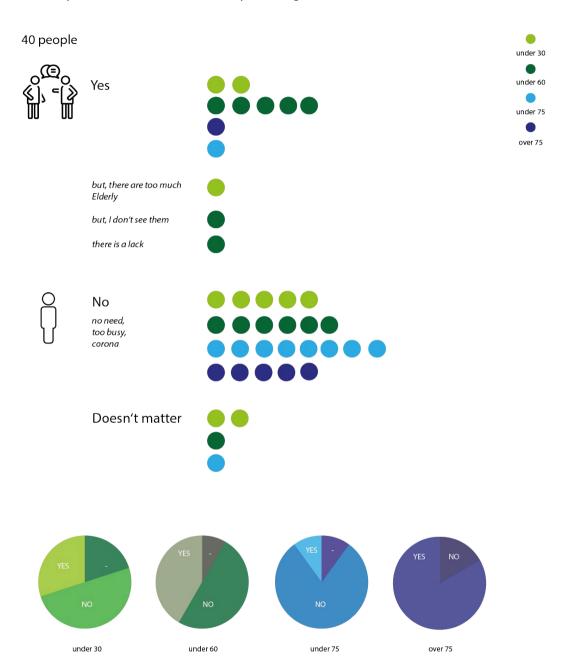

More contact, or not?

In general looking at the answers a minority of the respondents are in need for more social contact. According to them there is a lack and they don't see each other properly. The other part who answered that they do not need more contact mentioned that they do not have time and don't want to take risks due to corona. Also a lot of respondents didn't give a proper reason why they don't want to have more contact.

However looking at the answers divided by age, we see that the majority of the elderly above 75, indicated that they would like to have more contact with their neighbors.

HOW WILLING ARE THE RESIDENTS TO HELP OTHERS?

HELPING

What are you willing to do?

In this graph the willingness of different groups are shown. People in the age of 30-60 are the most willingly to help their neighbours. They are vital and have the time to help others. Walking their dogs and driving them to places are tasks that are the least favorite. These tasks take more time and are tasks that are different from their regular schedule. For example, doing groceries can be done when they are doing groceries for themselves.

The elderly are willing to do the less heavy tasks, like lending a cup of sugar or do some groceries. The people above 60 years old are less willing to help. Three of the people between 60 and 75 said that they don't want to do anything.

Driving people around is the least popular for all the groups



HELPING

How often?

The most important conclusion from this question is that people want to help their neighbour. The most said answer is when needed, so there is not really a time period given. When needed shows that they want to help their neighbour for a longer period of time: until the neighbour doesn't need help.

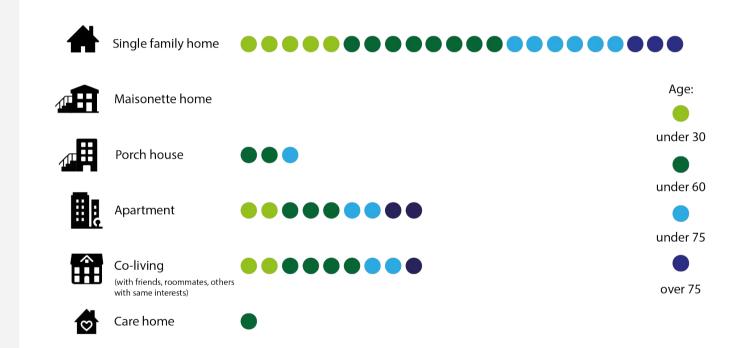

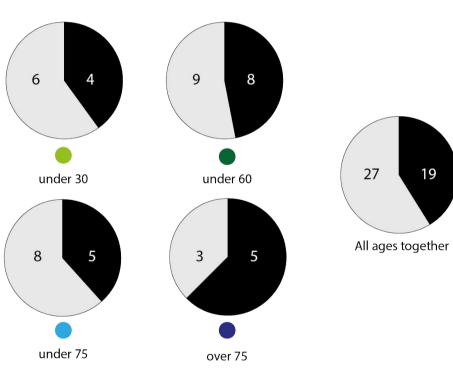

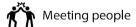












QUALITIES

For the view residents would like to have a view on nature, but a small percentage would also like to see what is going on in the living environment.

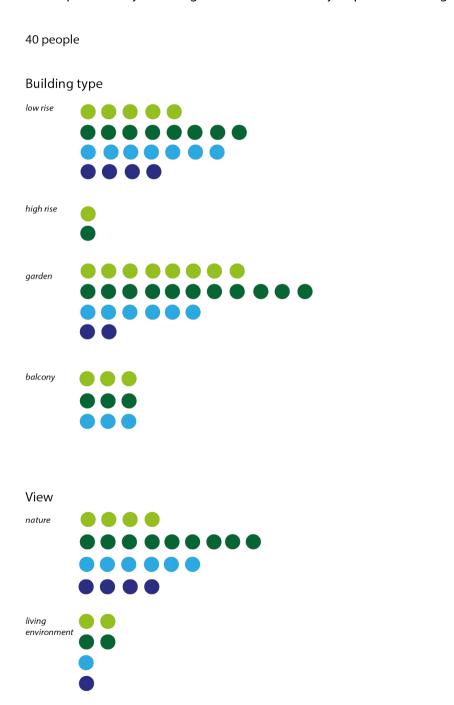
What qualities in your living environment would you prefer in old age?

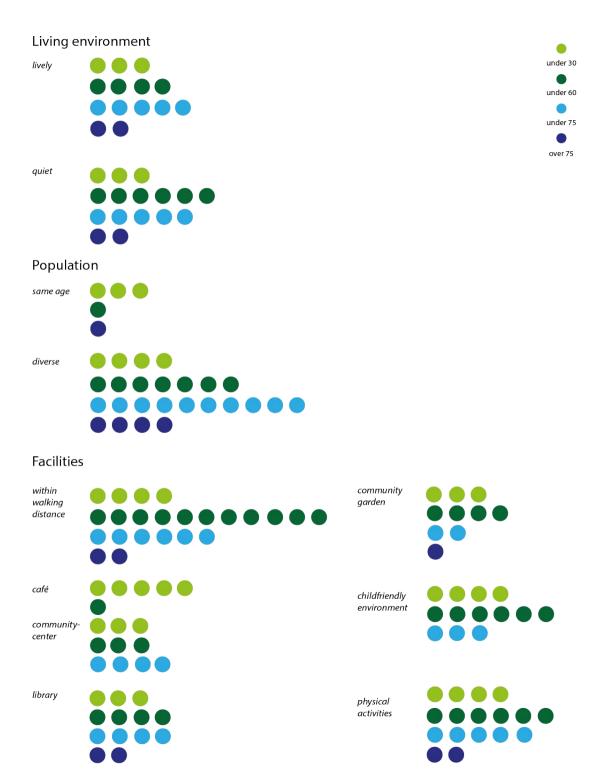
QUALITIES

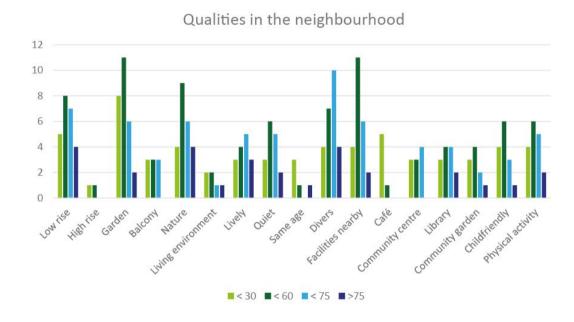

Also a place for sports, creative working place and a square for market or recreation is mentioned.

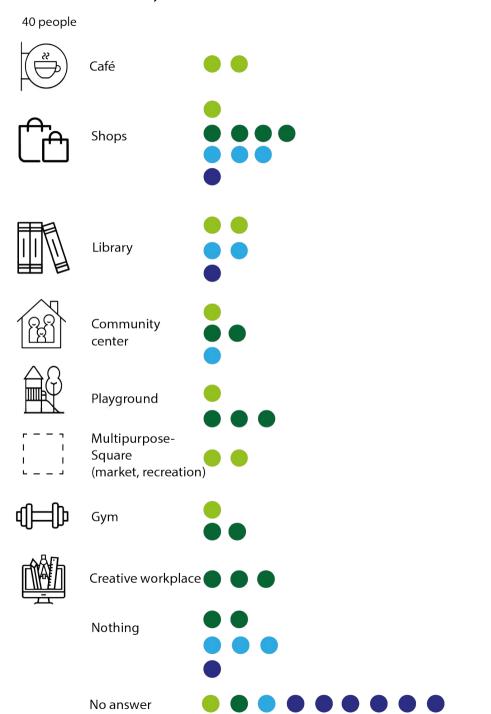
