

- 7. Student voice as a spark


The five principles for longivety

- 5. Design for transfer and adaptation




2. Growing and sustaining this change.

Phase 1




Focus on: Grow awareness, capture small wins, and use the intrinsic motivation of the initial participants.

Phase 2



Focus on: Growing participation and daily integration. Inspire more teachers, also include students for greater results.

Phase 3



Focus on: Cultural shift and systemic support. Expanding and getting more people on board. Keep alternating between phase 2 and phase 3 to ensure growth and integration.
