An adaptive collaborative approach to regional urban planning


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"How can we implement an adaptive governance strategy, based on the notion of collaborative planning, that draws upon the influence of actors from science, policy, and civil society?"



A flexible and adaptive planning system is created by introducing a multi-level governance approach. Within this approach communication is aimed at generating common interest. This is done through the pattern language method. The resulting patterns contain the region's ambitions and allow for creating a regional vision document. The urban regime is responsible for this. The vision is developed project-by-project through the use of small and temporary governance networks.
