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Primary scope: bring BSF abroad

Barilla aims to export BSF abroad: the first scope addressed during the graduation project consists of overcoming the barriers outlined by the different countries when **exporting BSF abroad** and minimizing the resistance caused by the system in force. The identified countries are Turkey and Russia.

Farmers are difficult to convince; the second scope consists of swaying farmers about the worthwhileness of deployed **methodologies** and the differences from their usual cultivating methods. The outcome is an educational framework to support the adoption of the tools and methodologies.

Barilla for farmers: the platform To accomplish both the scopes of the graduation project, two roadmaps implement a supportive platform in Russia and Turkey, countries with low education levels. The platform will guide farmers in understanding Barilla's Guidelines for Sustainable Agriculture through microlearning activities and allow the participation to offline workshops. The roadmaps guide the company through a step by step process to implement the educational framework in countries where Barilla purchases wheat for pasta.
