_a portmanteau that means both outside of and in addition to statecraft


_treats the territory as 'terra nullis', where the infrastructural system is filled with well rehearsed order of events products of that model

'The habitat of fish is organized in horizontal bands within the water's profile; some stay directly under the surface, others move about within their own specific level in the depths of the water. Fish react to wavelengths of light which are filtered through the various depths of the water. As the light intensity changes during each 24-hour cycle species start migrating in vertical direction to find their prey, penetrating other layers and braking out of their horizontal column. This daily movement is like weaving through aquatic space.'


