Social Enterprises as a solution for creating access to socio-economic resources


Social Enterprise...

- Any activity that has an entrepreneurial base and the main goal of it is to promote the socio-economic status of a community.
- Social enterprise could be considered as providing services for the people who dont have control over their economic life which could be done in different ways like *training, providing production tools and spaces* (OECD, 2010; Carpenter, 2013).








