






FRAME:

Glass and mirrors: spatial assemblages via reflection and transparency.






It is a sunny morning, When the prisoner escapes his village. In his left hand a sword, in the right a bleeding rooster.


Toward the market he's rushing. Bleating howls repel people on the streets, Ghosts in the wild retreat. Combining Frames with Associations



In the wooden cabin at one end of the street, Works a sewing machine that never stops.


Out of the waving pedal walk the pants, Out of the pecking needle the shirts. On their way feeling to the other end of the street, The pants lost their shirts.

Vernissage:


Lines of refined windows between refined tufa Extend from the depth of museum of history. Behind some windows a tie, some an eye.
