How do we want to live in the future and what kind of buildings do we need to make that possible?

Research Question:

"How can affordable housing for the middle income family in the Minervahaven of Amsterdam be realized according to their specific needs?"



Research Question:

What are the wishes of urban families with regard to the appearance of the building block in which they live?

How can different types of family households be housed in one building block?

How can social control on the communal outdoorspace be stimulated with architectural elements?







Design Challenge

How to provide a highly urban residential building with suitable housing for different types of urban families, in which they could live independently and participate in the community life?

Modern families need more flexible/
private space to organise the new social structure

Focus on **flexible private** dwellings between 50 and 120 m2

Focus on communal dwellings between 90-180 m2


The work-living balance for parents is the starting point of the design

Provide the building with enough and suitable **outdoor space** for young children to play safely

Provide support for modern (patchwork) families by introducing **communal units**, collective spaces and public functions in the building
