




The complexity of the city doesn't allow me to think about it in terms of a single site.. Who do you want to impact? i guess i don't know it yet...



Dealing with the research about communities i had the chance to discover how the city was shaped and how nowadays it is structured from social point of view.

Starting point

- * lack of a shared identity and of a common goal shared between the inhabitants of the city (hills + plan)
- * Decay of the Barrio Puerto in particular

how to ensure that the identity of the place will remain the same still having a dialogue changing the bad image that the neighborhood has?

how to make different actors cooperate in a productive way? (to collaborate)

more from all "organisative" point of view.
⇒ how to get things done?

And from a SPATIAL point of view?
how to revitalize the area? What does it need?

→ LACK OF COMMONS and public spaces
that's what the different community organizations are trying to achieve with their work.

being there engaged with the "internal" actors. It makes you feel RAGE and FEAR which are the drivers

→ the idea would be then to use the strategy of URBAN ACUPUNCTURE in order to create a constellation of commons starting from the decay of the place itself, (let the USE and the REPURPOSE of the decaying spaces unlock resources)

constellation of commons able to connect the external and the internal sea of the city at first

provide an operational framework that allows all the actors to be involved in the change, hence through the repurposing of spaces let the inhabitants to be empowered.

→ Eventually (maybe too large scale) but this model could also be proposed throughout the other areas, ~~Gentring~~ and this CONSTELLATION OF COMMONS within the city (starting ~~from~~ always from the decay of the city itself) could produce a city that share the same identity? more collaborative.

What I found in my research?

Mainly projects done by privates or for instance the ones done by La Corporacion MATRIZ and just a little projects done by the REAL COMMUNITY such as the ones of this org. called SOLMPS BARRIOPUERTO (cleaning of the streets and soon)

→ through the research we'd done onsite, we tried to invert this knowledge, starting from this more "intangible" groups and to make them give us insights about the other groups acting in the area.





"Intervention is all about revitalization, an indispensable way of making an organism function and change".

"However, sometimes, a simple, focused intervention can create new energy, demonstrating the possibilities of a space in a way that motivates others to engage with their communities".

"[...] the imperative of PRESERVING or RESTORING the cultural identity of a place or a community"
→ "Recuperate collective loss of memory and identity".

DON'T BE PRETENTIOUS! → place where exchange.
the role of the **BUS STOP** → think about Paris!!!
* Business of the streets in the Almendral VS the one in the Barrio Puerto and up to the hills.

In fact it's mainly people who attract people. Man is both a protagonist and a spectator in the drama of everyday life unfolding on the city stage."
→ "Good acupuncture [...] is about helping the city become a catalyst of interactions between people."

(What universities can learn from el Barrio Puerto?)

"CURITIBA, encouraging residents to exchange their garbage for bus tokens"!
"tax-free zone in the favelas, lovely idea!"

"Good Urban Acupuncture is also the art of stimulating knowledge about the city"

"[...] But scale has nothing to do with the fact that a proposal may be unviable, nor the lack of funds. What is important is the correct vision, and a competent set-up of a "coresponsibility equation". What's needed is a scenario, or an idea, a desirable concept. And all of the people - or most - will help bring it to fruition. It's precisely at the moment of execution that a people's self esteem helps a city move forward."



"Urban interstices"

↳ "places of freedom away from the norm of society" (Lynch)

→ they are always the product of previous processes of urban planning and design.

1. Dominant mode of treatment of the interstice
→ institutional perspective and action, empty the interst.
2. Ad-hoc improvised int. uses, always keep in mind the frame of perception and action imposed by the main actors (owners,...) → pushes to a "just passing" behavior.

"the interstice exists between a functional past and a future" / time
→ temporary absence of attributed function.

"from a user's perspective int. are available spaces inbetween other more functionally identified places".

- Disorder associated with the interstices is caused by the lack of meaningful correspondence between a place and a person.
→ the "just passing" behavior

↳ a way to relate to the interstices.

theory of ECOLOGICAL PERCEPTION (Gibson)

Affordances are the resources of the environment...

the REDUCED CONDITIONS correspond to a situation where most of the perception of the interstice is determined by "mental sets or attentional biases" (which are largely established by the external context) [Shepard], here the dominant frame imposed by institutional actors. It prevents closer attention to the actual space of the interstice.

In the case of Valparaiso, and its interstices, they are not "failures of urban development", they are more the result of a policy of neglect. (→ after fire, earthquakes, ... no plans for reconstruction and so on.)



- **COMMON SPACES** "Sites open to public use in which, however, rules and norms of use do not depend upon and are not controlled by a prevailing authority. It is through practices of COMMONING, practices which define and produce goods and services to be shared, that certain city spaces are created as common spaces."
(Commoning practices)

CAPITALIST ENCLOSURE of the commons. → obstructing commoning practices that tend towards an openness of sharing.

SPACE as a means of establishing and expanding common practices.

POLITICAL SUBJECTIVATION

/ subjects of political action emerge today by (...) dismounting dominant social taxonomies and the corresponding established identities. In this process **contemporary urban space**, which necessarily expresses and reproduces these dominant taxonomies, can possibly be transformed through collective action.
