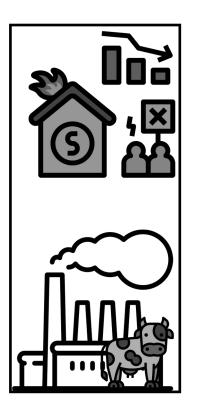
Research sub-questions

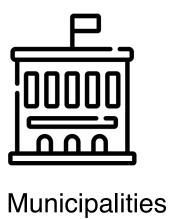
- 1. What are the key conditions and stakeholders for developing housing on livestock farm locations in the Netherlands, and what are the essential aspects in the development process?
