























diversity in building parts

- recognisable: provides sense of place
- mysterious: encourages to explore









unclear routing

- many corners: makes orientation difficult
- no daylight or views: reduced stimulation
- institutional lighting implies large scale












Section KK' including Northwest Elevation of the Kitchen and Cafe
