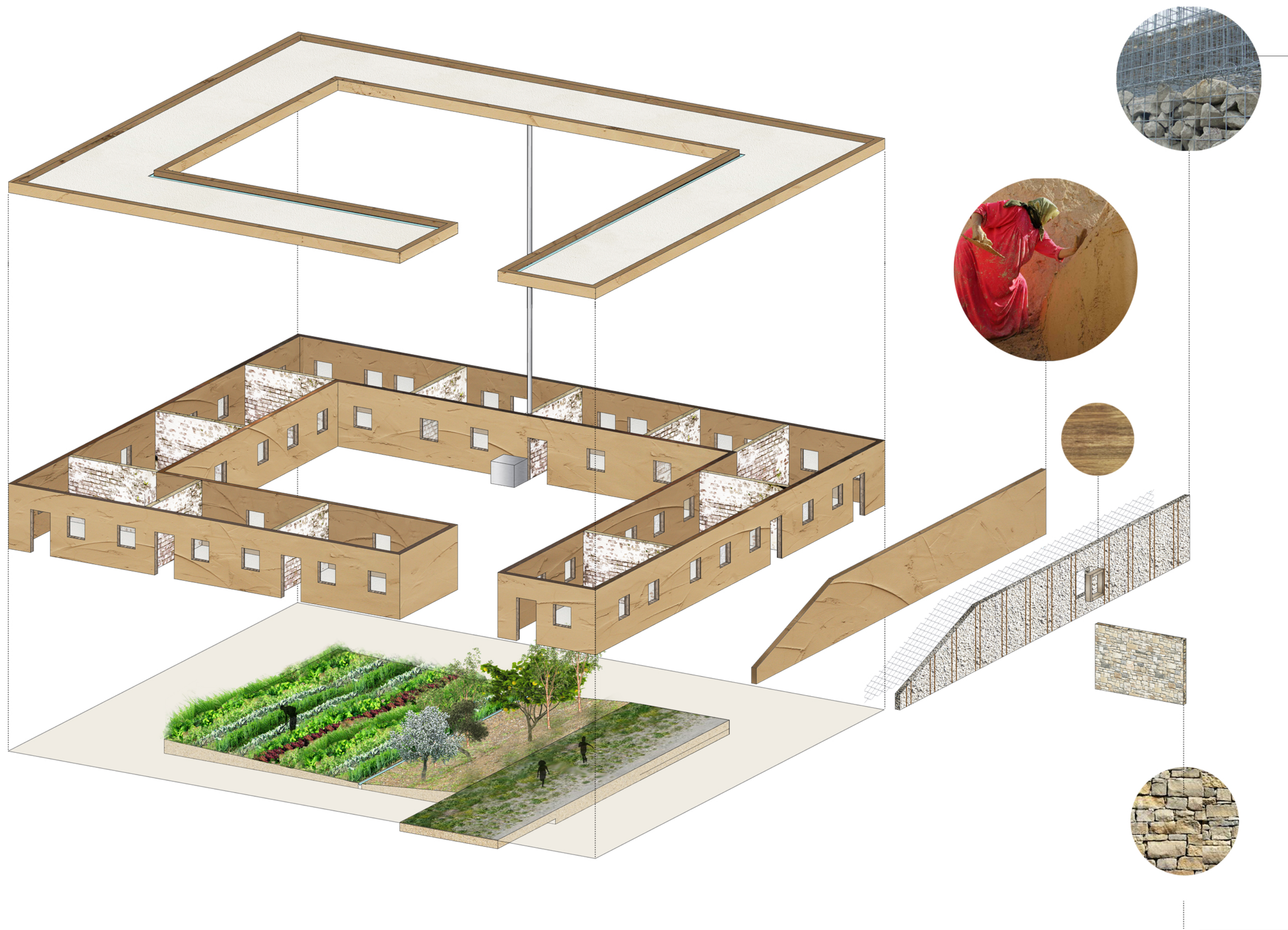
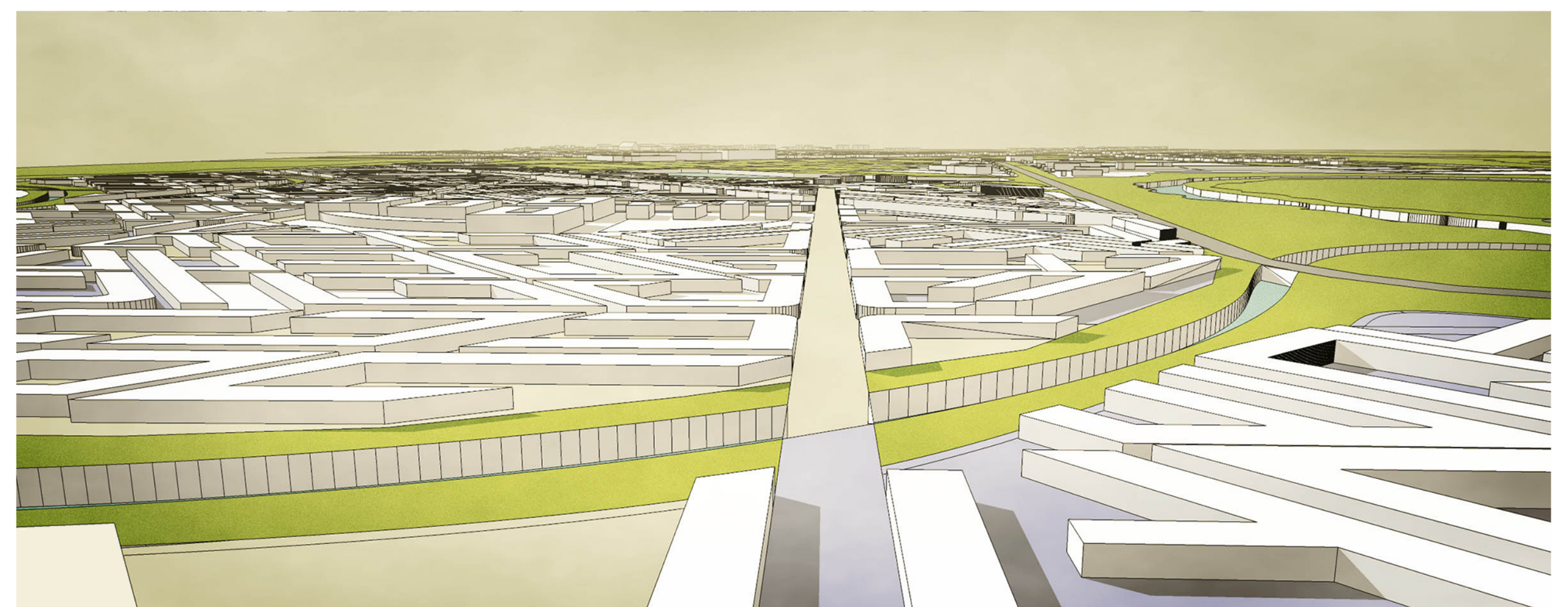

## the standard vs. the local

The well "Majen": collects rain water from a burt lime washed rooftop acting as a filter (vernacular technique). Local materials in a span of 5 km from the camp: the digged materials from the natural rehabilitation, the surrounding quarries are all providers for this local construction.  
The courtyard: a secured place with a vegetable garden for family use
