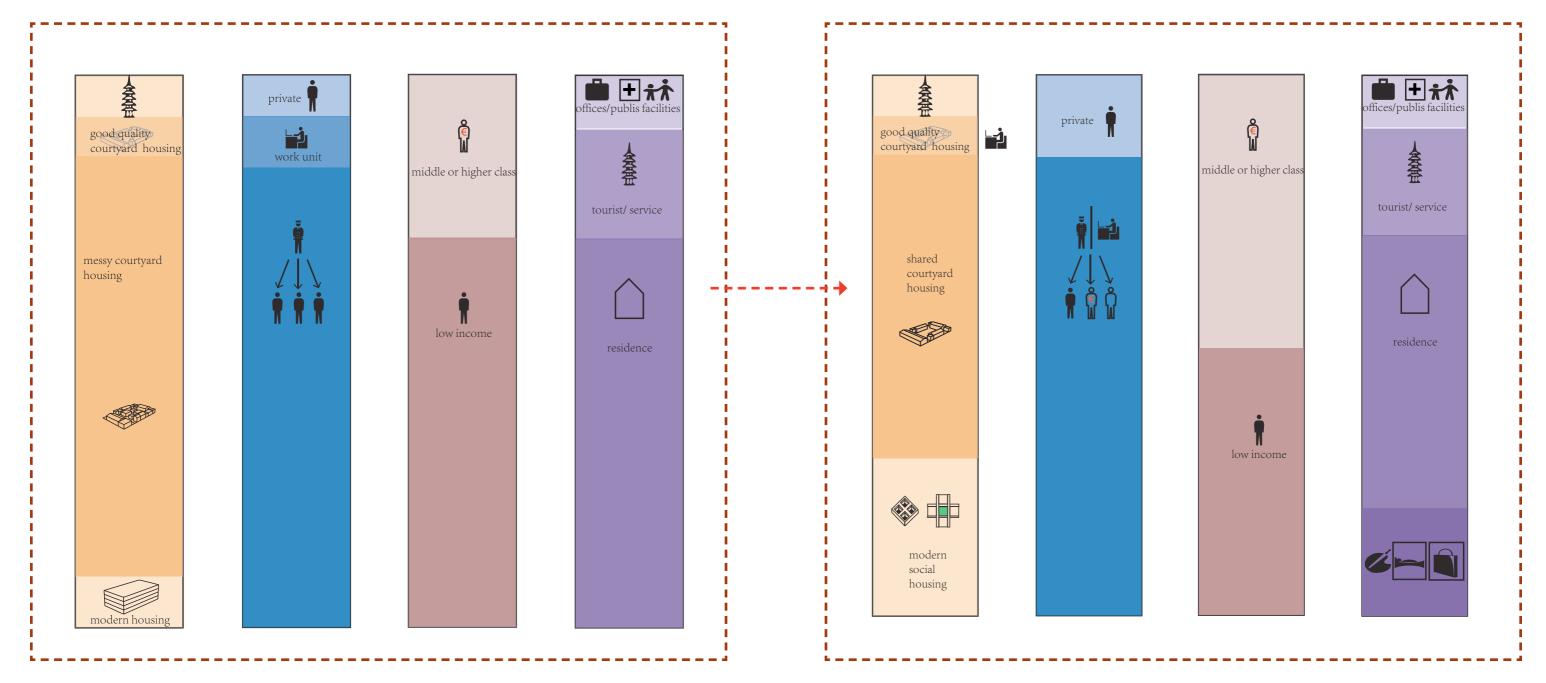


#### **Proposal for Gulou districts regeneration**
