- Hindrance in ability to realize housing preferences
- Impediment to the residential mobility on the housing market

- 46,658 respondents
- 20,778 aged 55 and older
- 135 respondents aged 55 and older

- No desire to move
- Potentially want to move
- Want to move

- Already found a dwelling
- Want to move but unable to find a dwelling

### Desire to move if a dwelling that meets their desires would be present



- Desire to movePotentially a desire to move
- No desire to move

### Extent of interest to in housing types with common spaces



- Common (indoor) space to meet others & common (vegetable) garden
- People of different ages
- Less than 20 households
