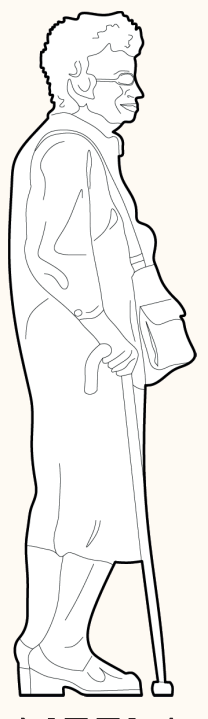

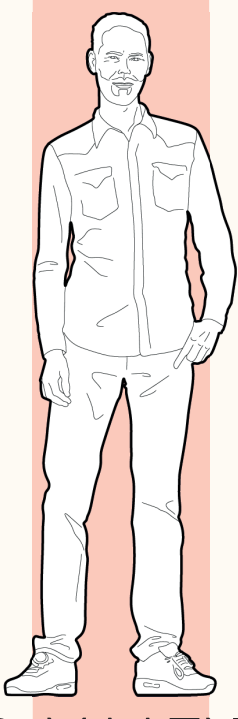


LONELY PEOPLE

social loneliness



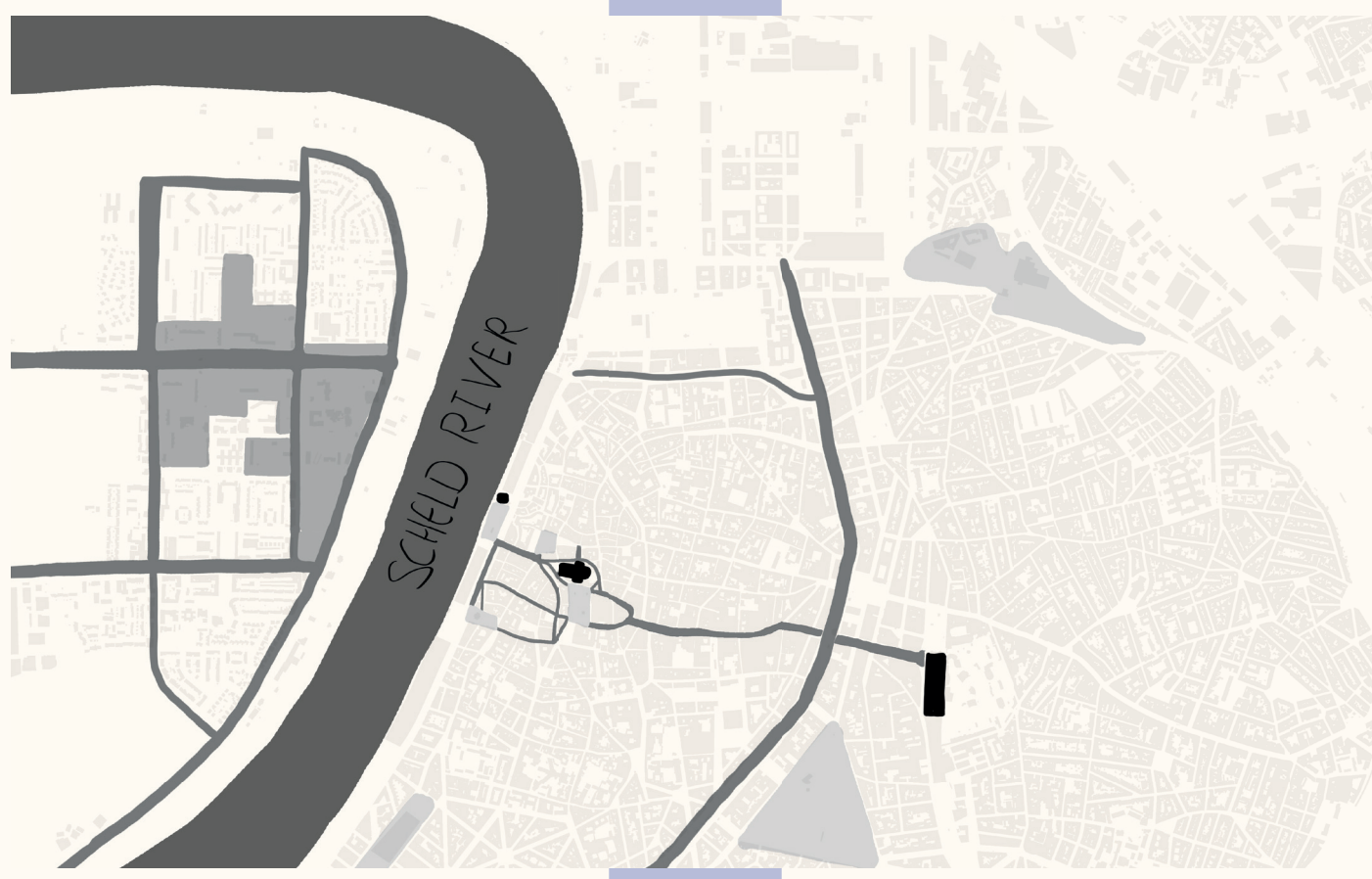
MR. MAAZNEE
