1862 Synagoge founded 1860 Boarding school closed


1898 Headbuilding built by Hartman with large frontgarden

1986 Gasthuis closed: all buildings are demolished except for the Zusterhuis and the historic wall 2012 Zusterhuis transformed in creative hub














Architectural design the new Waldorf School Architectural design proposal floor plan ground floor 1:300 D



Entrance and great hall longitudinal section 1:100




Climate design concept for ventilation and heating











Order of construction placing floors, columns and slabs





Facade segment of the great hall 1:75





