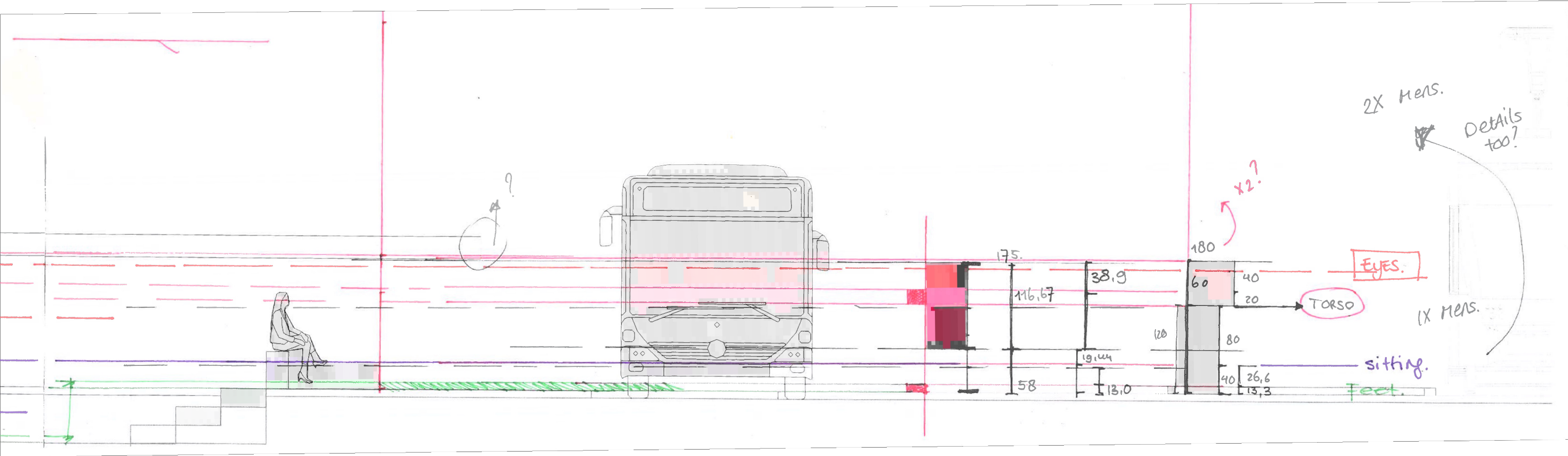














Maria, 32

Lives in Pirita and uses public transport mainly to go to school in the city centre.

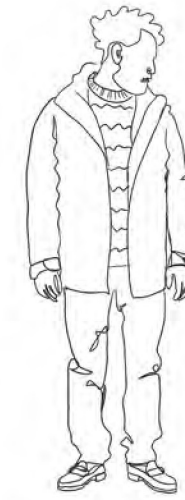
Uses a combination of tram and bus.

Combination of bus and walking.



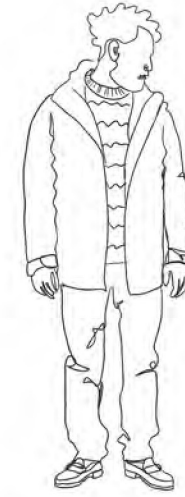
