
The program of the building constitutes in a social framework functioning as a collective house for diversity, effectively acting as a charitable institution, where twenty four rooms offer a place to students disadvantaged by their ethnicity and the white, secular tradition that exists within University. The UvA Diversity Committee, established to enhance diversity, will offer students of non-western backgrounds or of a first-generation an ability to feel at home. They are welcomed to build on a grounded community where they are empowered by the architecture and grandeur of the context and recognised as an integral part of the campus, solidifying their position within the University.

In exchange the individuals will have to run the public cafe and host activities in the public room of the building, enacting as an imperative urban platform, addressing wider relations within the city of Amsterdam and acting on notions as diversity, integration, inclusivity, egalitarianism, decolonisation and discrimination of any kind.




























