Volt is a product-service-system consisting of a smart phone case and a dedicated app. Through the phone case, you can easily save by clicking a button and check how you are doing financially thanks to a coloured light, located above the button. The dedicated app helps you create digital vaults to budget into your personal goals, it gradually teaches you about finances and puts you together with people with a similar money lifestyle.

Budget on personal life goals

You can allocate money into budgets, called volts, where money is put into what matters you most (buy a house, get married, go to a trip), including of course an emergency fund for unexpected events, you never know when you will need that extra help.

Check financial health

The app shows progress towards your goals and your financial health in the main dashboard, trigger you to do money better.

Meet others with the same financial situation

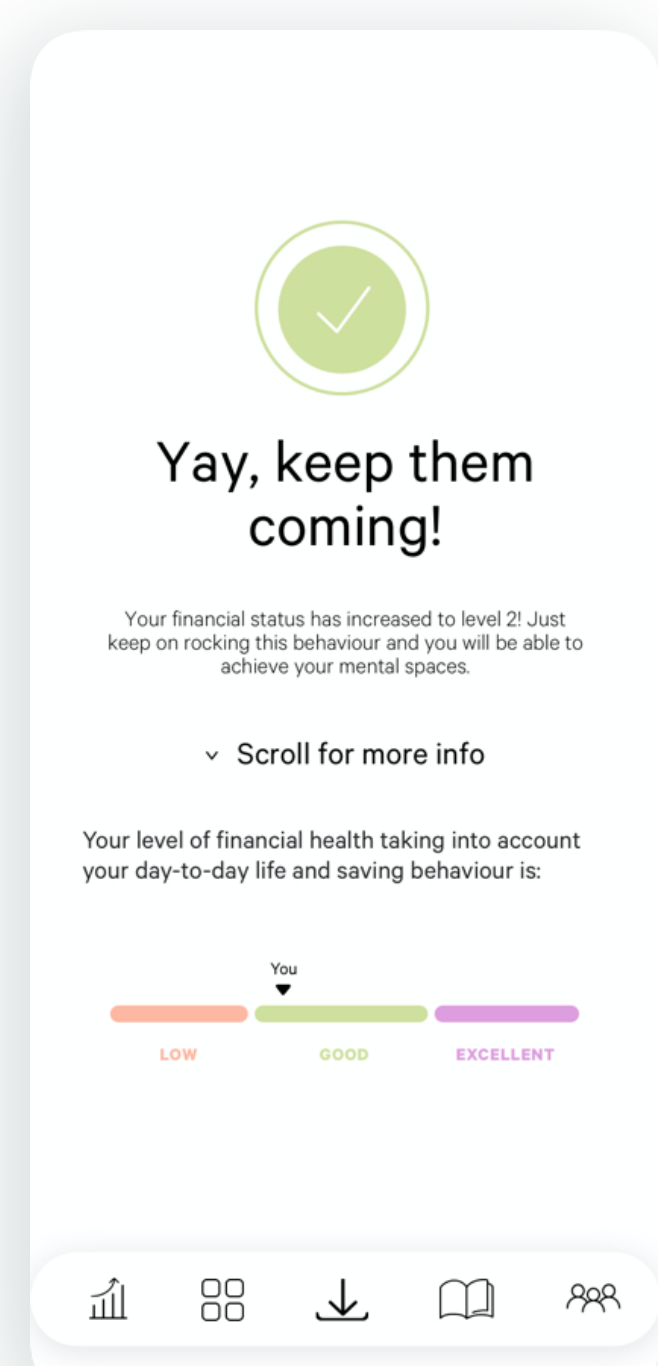
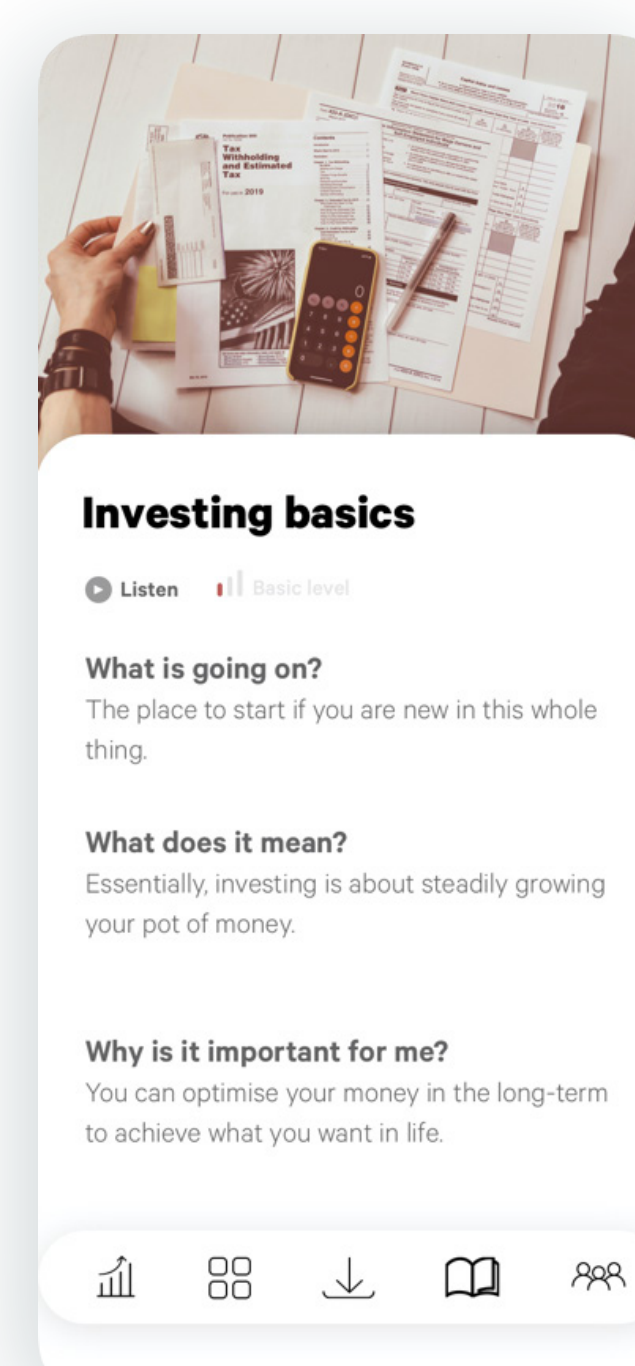
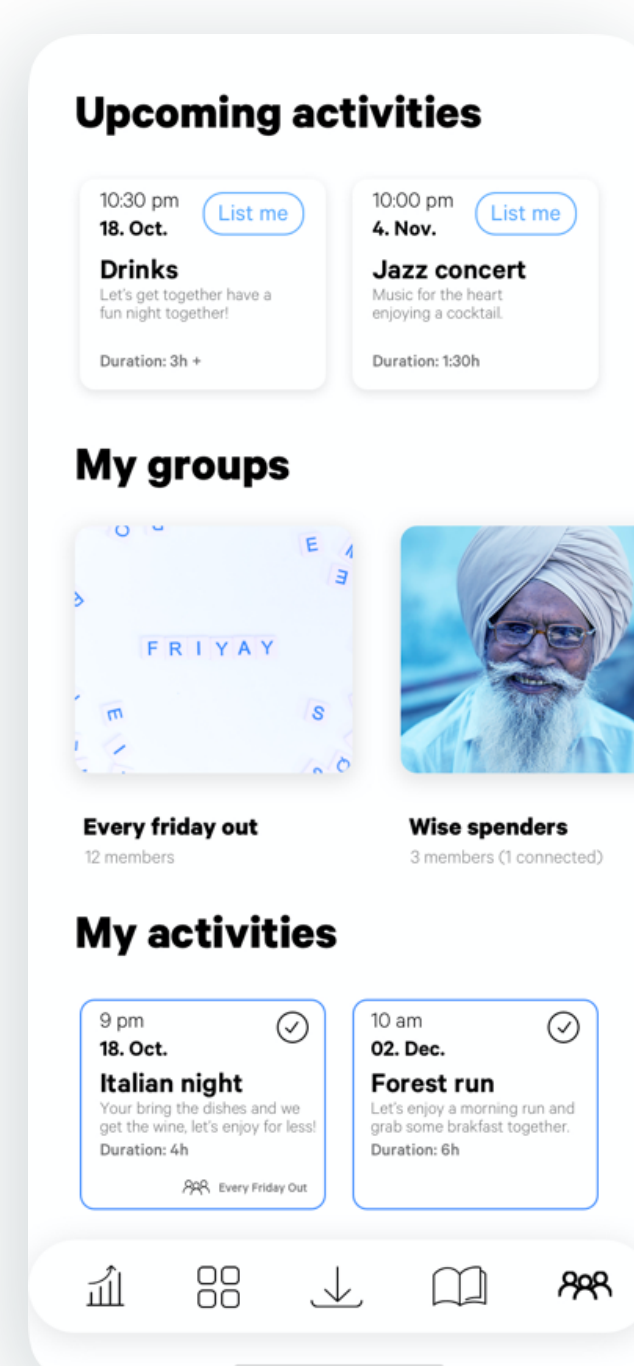
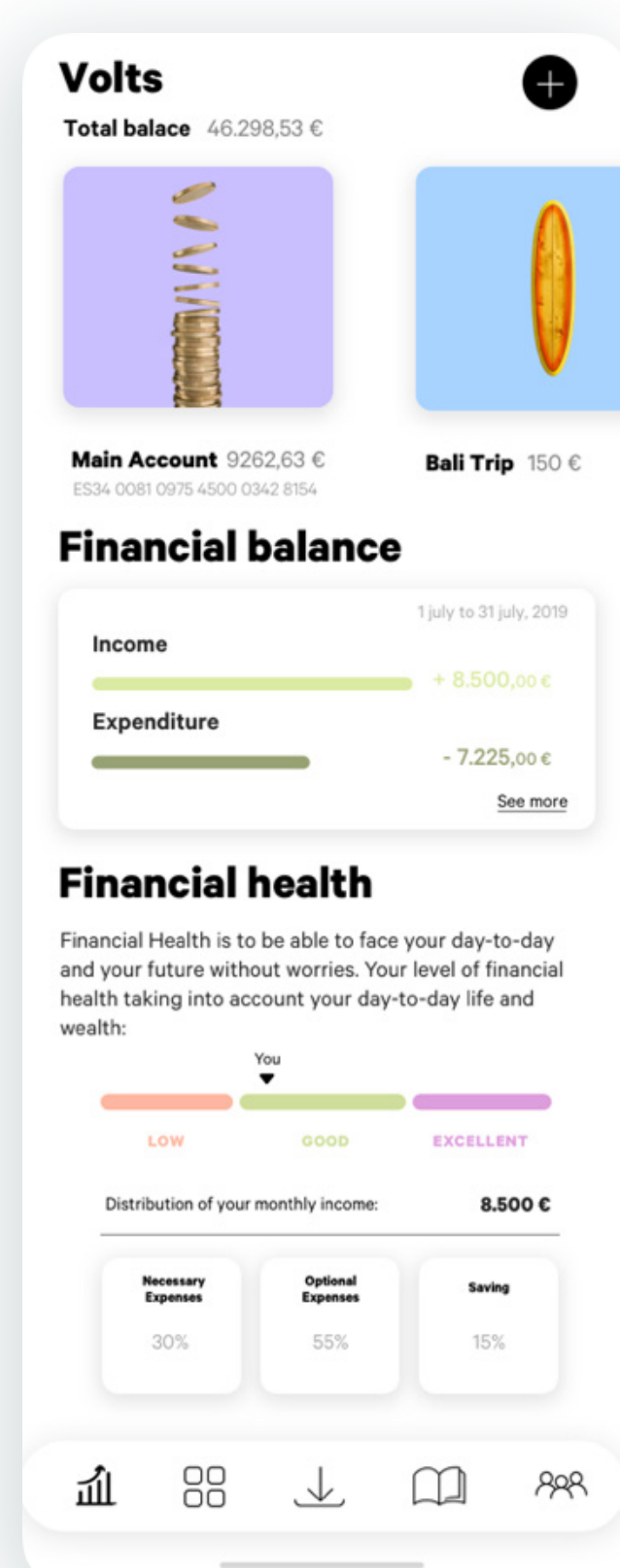
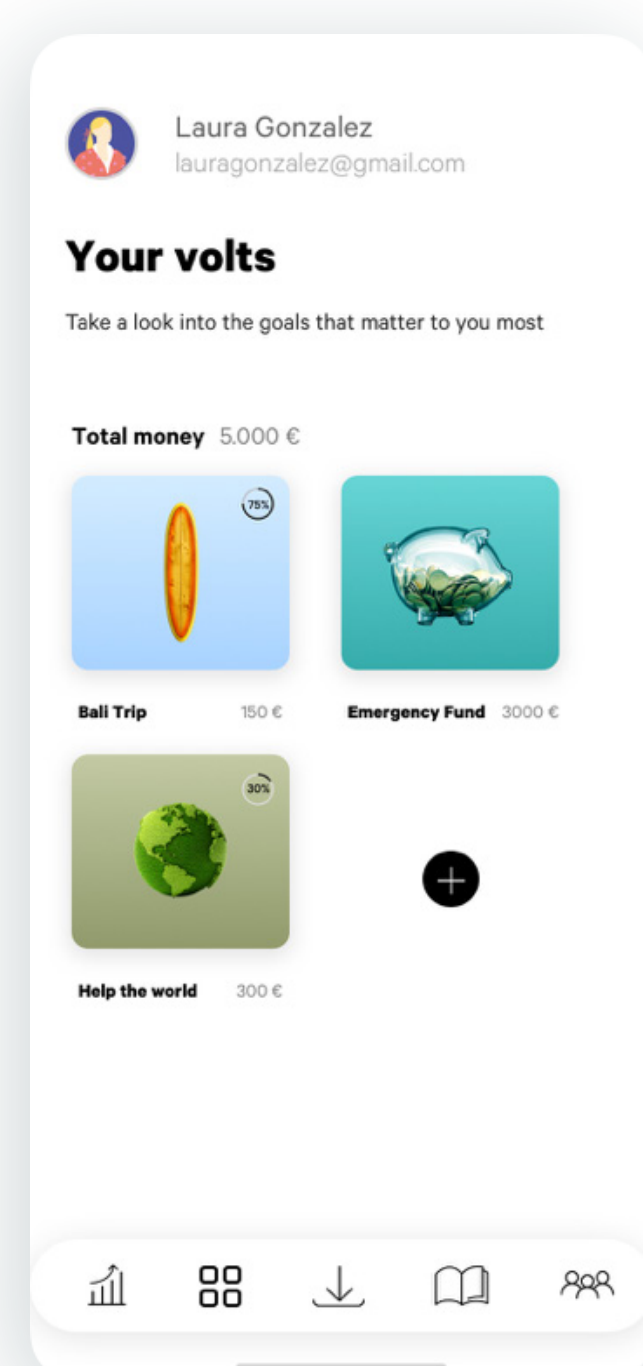
By meeting others with the same financial situation, you will break free from your current financial pressures and enjoy alternative activities.
