





Rotor is a cooperative design practice that investigates material flows in the construction industry. It develops critical positions on design, material resources and waste through research, exhibitions, publications and consultancy.


On a practical level Rotor handles the design and realization of architectural projects and acts as a supplier of reclaimed materials.

More specifically, they're active in the dismantling, the conditioning and the sale of reclaimed construction elements.




Detail: longitudinal section










