### Rotterdam Crooswijk

- Working-class neighbourhood in Rotterdam
- One of the original neighbourhoods
- Known for it's social cohesion
- Strongly associated with the 'real' Rotterdammer and the Rotterdam dialect



### Urban renewal

Nieuw Crooswijk

- Early 2000s
- Urban renewal in Nieuw Crooswijk
- Leading to:
- 1. A completely altered physical appearance
- 2. Large demographic shift



### Forcing current residents out As a result of the urban renewal

- Attempt to make the city more attractive for higher incomes
- Makeover offered room for upper-class
- Disregarding the current working-class
- Leading to gentrification

"When they start demolishing, the only have room for 450 social houses.

Where do the rest of the Crooswijk-natives have to go?" "To the next about to be demolished neighbourhood ofcourse!

# Spreading fear in Oud Crooswijk

- Currently in need of renewal
- First visible signs of gentrification
- Residents fear their area is next



'This is a working-class'' neighbourhood. But people want us out. The 'Yuppen' (upper-class) are going to kick me out"

"Crooswijk has been ruined, and I fear this cannot be fixed anymore..."

"It all started when they started renovating Nieuw Croosijk."



"People are chased out. People had a rent of €350,-. They were promised to be able to return after the renovation. However, their rent increased to €720,- which they could not afford of course."

"Everyone helped each other, everyone knew and greeted each other. Nowadays, if you say hello to someone, they will not even look at you."



# Problem Statement

"Urban renewal threatens to push out the current inhabitants and alter the physical appearance of the neighbourhood.

As a result, Oud Crooswijk could become completely unrecognizable, removing the working-class character of the neighbourhood."

# The importance of the working-class

- Working-class = DNA
- The DNA makes Rotterdam unique and attractive

### **Bold**

Rotterdam is a city that's direct and unpolished. Rotter-dammers say what they mean. Rotterdam is a city where anything is possible. Rotterdam is constantly changing and never finished. The city is young and unpolished. This means that anyone can contribute to the city and connect with it.

### **Forward**

In Rotterdam it doesn't matter where you come from, it matters where you're going. Those who want to create something new can find what they want in Rotterdam. Rotterdam is the city of initiative and innovation.


### Culture

  - Manual labour professions






### Character of Oud Crooswijk Present

  - Manual labour professions





# Crooswijk Early development


- Originated in the late 1800s
- Non-planned city-expansion
- Unwanted industries for the inner-city
- Urbanization of local polders



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# Crooswijk Densification

- Speculative development
- Following old waterways
- Heavy densification
- Compact public space as a result
- Expensive houses along the singels



Crooswijk Birth of Nieuw Crooswijk

- Further expansion of Rotterdam
- Planned development



# Crooswijk

Large scale urban renewal

- Oud Crooswijk was not hit during the bombings of WWII
- Focus was on rebuilding the city
- Crooswijk was neglected in the years following WWII






### Crooswijkseweg as the main street

- 1A: Street profile proportions of at least 1:1
- 1B: Activating plinths

- 1H: Preserving characteristic parcel- and building corners






- 2A: Adding trees on the old waterways

## Neighbourhood gardens & renovated building blocks


- 3A: Preserving the spatial characteristics of a notplanned expansion neighbourhood
- 3B: Medium sized apartment houses
- 3C: Tenement building entries
- 3D: Many facade openings
- 3E: Three-way split facades
- 3F: Flat or pitched roofs
- 3G: Interwoven horizontal and vertical facade elements
- 3H: Maximum building height of 5 layers and 16 meters
- 3I: Straigh building lines
- 3J: Preservation of historic and monumental elements
- 3K: Presence of open spaces





## A pedestrian friendly neighbourhood

- 4A: No (personal) car parking space
- 4B: Clustered parking facilities for commercial vehicles
- 4C: Creating more bicycle parking facilities
- 4D: Preserving and enhancing accessibility by public transit
- 4E: Neighbourhood remains accessible by cars
- 4F: One-way streets








- Functions to be removed 186 houses 1 school gym 1 kindergarten




# To build & renovate

- Full compensation
- Total new floor space: 26,585 m<sup>2</sup>
- Newly developed

1 Schools (840 m²) 1 Kindergarten (750 m²) 1 School gym (375 m²) 205 (120 m² each)
