


#### ANALYSIS

- Current public space system consist of the front-side of high street and the backside of high street


- The on-high-street public spaces is the current hotspot for local life, while the back-high-street public spaces a segregated from the current activeness

groups. - Paradox of development. + Defining and reinforcing the "Good Growth" in public domain in Hackney. + Defining Hackney's local


characters. + Delivering a Hackneybased inclusive design content in public domain.


### RESEARCH QUESTION


How to deliver cohesive public life by operating the inclusive spatial intervention in public domain, in order to promote the "Good Growth" in Hackney?









