student convent


The design can be described as a 'student convent'. A meeting of different people and buildings. It is a statement for the prescence of CREA the cultural student centre in the centre of Amsterdam.

The cultural centre as a place for students to experiment, express and interact with the city.

The design consist of a main hall build up out of a repititive structure and an encircling wall. Rising up between the hall and the surrounding, both inside and outside spaces are being created through extensions and exclusions. At the centre of the scheme, the hall and the wall together form the public court. While the perimeter is formal in its arrangement, it connects and extends the existing routing of the Oudemanhuispoort and the surroundings. These transitional spaces become part of a


