ADAPTIVE GOVERNANCE

The term of adaptive governance define a group of several stakeholders involved in a collaborative and equalitarian approach. It includes not only good governance and citizen's participation but a collaboration among the different stakeholders involved in the urban development, understanding their own role and promoting the power distribution. The concept raises from the assumption that the **changes are** going to exist in the complex reality of informal cities and they should be un-derstood as an opportunity for renewal and reorganization. It introduces the relation between a changing reality and the necessity of a flexible policy framework where there is scope for responding to shifting circumstances.

- Definition of the different roles of each stakeholder
