





# MUSIC IN TIME: HISTORY AND BECOMING


Music is the deterritorialization of the refrain, and in this sense the refrain is "the block of content proper to music" (MP 368; 299). The refrain itself, of course, is a complex of deterritorialization and reterritorialization, its three aspects being those of a point of order, a circle of control, and a line of flight to the outside. The refrain territorializes chaos in forming a milieu; it deterritorializes milieu components and reterritorializes them in a territory proper; and deterritorializing forces constantly play through the territory, thereby opening it to the cosmos as a whole. Yet the basic function of the refrain is "essentially territorial, territorializing or reterritorializing, whereas music makes of it a deterritorialized content for a deterritorializing form of expression" (MP 369; 300). The refrain, then, is "a way of impeding, of conjuring music or doing away with it" (MP 368; 300). Music takes the refrain as its content and transforms it by entering into a process of "becoming" that deterritorializes the refrain.

# RUYER AND THE MELODIES OF DEVELOPMENTAL BIOLOGY

Von Uexküll recognizes the importance of developmental melodies in the symphony of nature, but for a detailed elaboration of this notion one must turn to Raymond Ruyer, a philosopher whom Deleuze and Guattari cite with some frequency. In a series of books, including La Conscience et le corps (1937), Eléments de psycho-biologie (1946), Néofinalisme (1952), and La Genèse des formes vivantes (1958), Ruyer articulates a philosophy of biology centered on the formative activity of all living beings. Ruyer's controlling insight is that the morphogenesis of a living entity can never be explained via a mechanistic causality-through-contiguity, but must presume the existence of a formative theme or melody controlling its development. Following Whitehead, Ruyer distinguishes between living forms—self-shaping, self-sustaining, and self-enjoying entities—and aggregates, quantitative collections of entities whose forms are determined by external forces, and hence are explicable in terms of mechanistic causal relations. Examples of aggregates are clouds, ocean currents, geological formations, and human crowds.
