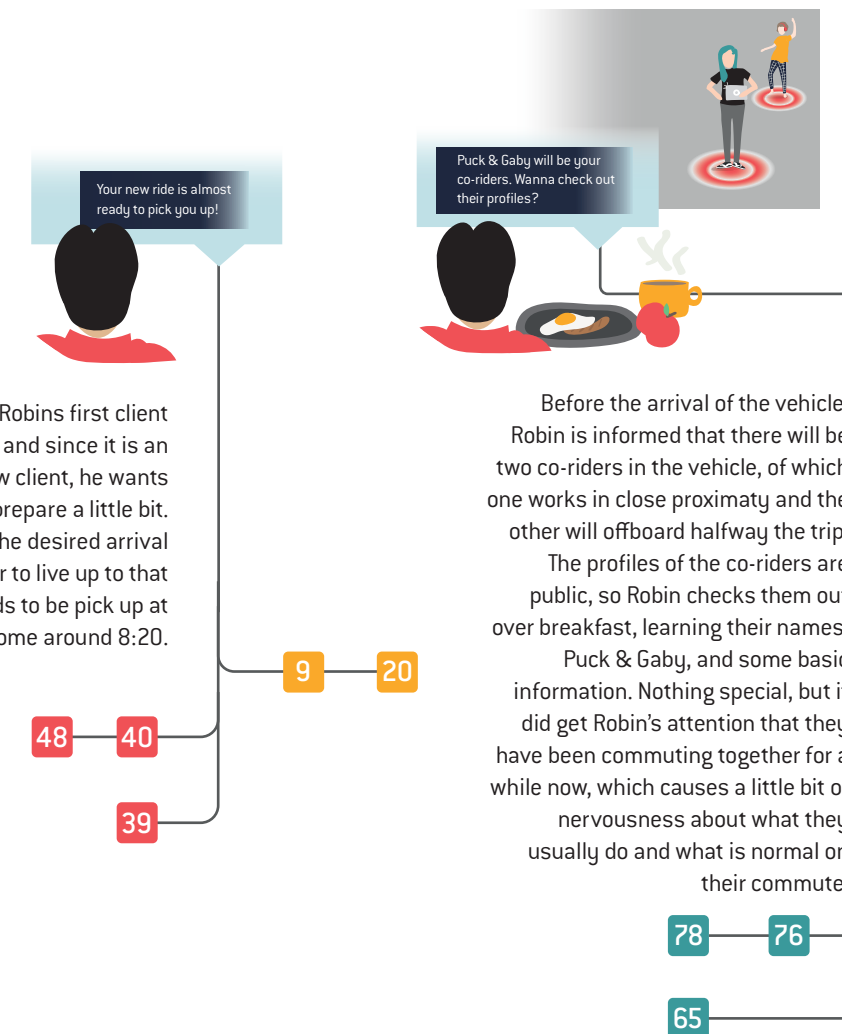

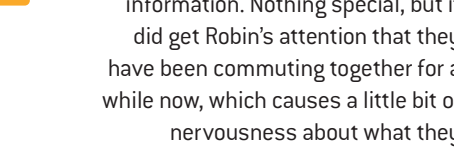


Your new ride is almost ready to pick you up!

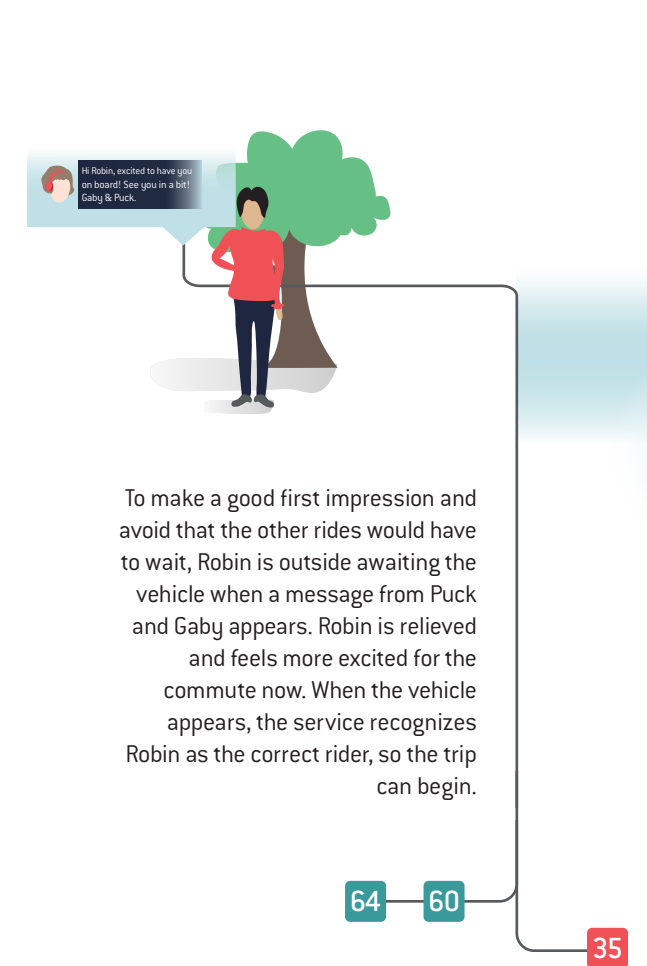
Puck & Gaby will be your co-riders. Wanna check out their profiles?

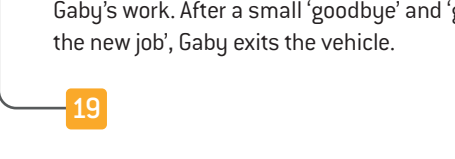
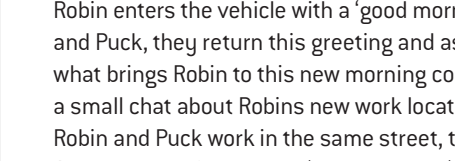
GOOD MORNING!

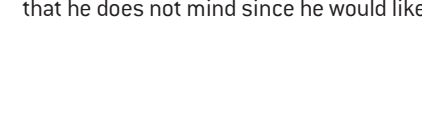
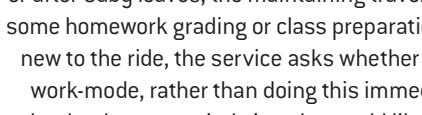
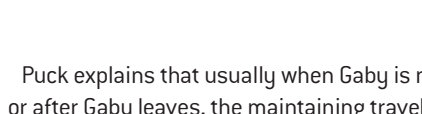
Do you want to switch to work mode?



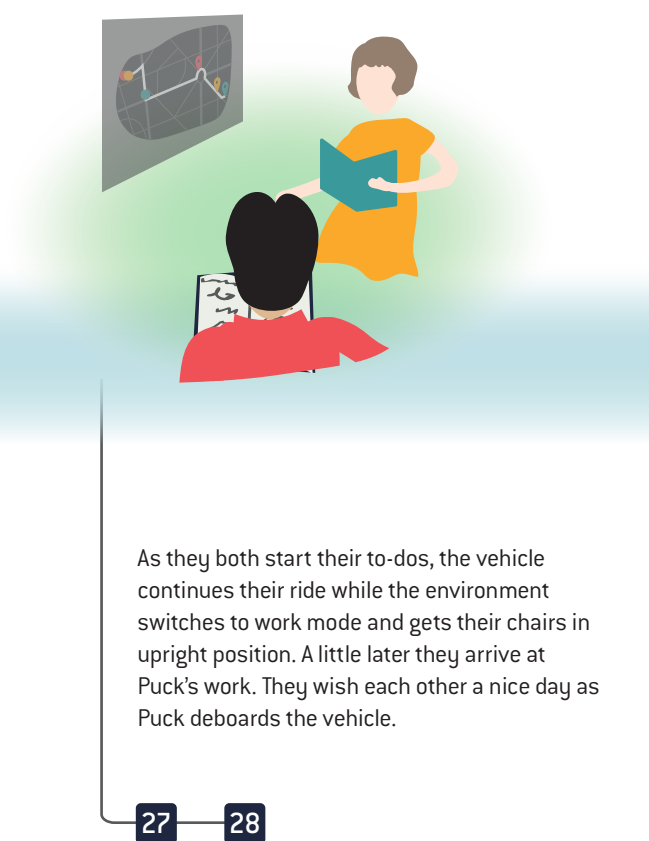

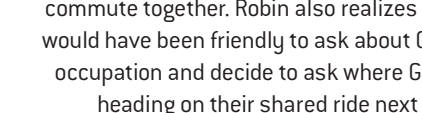
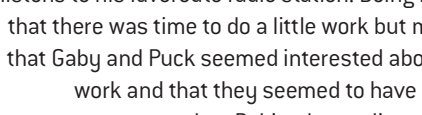
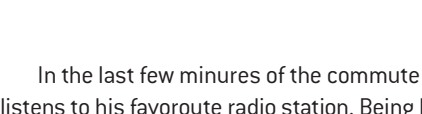
Do you want to switch to work mode?
