A TWO-FOLD DISCOVERY AT BOUNDARY WALLS

- physical description -

It is a single-layer brick wall, 3m in height, constructed in common bond. It is completely solid in order to block visibility into the college area. It serves to define the territory of the school parking lot. On top of the brick wall, extra wired fence is installed to provide extra security, as the street is often parked with many trucks and cars.

- personal experience -

Without murals covering the wall, it makes me confused whether the area behind it still belongs to the school. Perhaps without murals, it is covered with scattered graffiti, and even hooks installed on it to hang advertising posters. With the poster, it became a backdrop for an outdoor cafe for the street vendor, who sells empanadas across the street.

How could these boundary walls communicate an equivocal definition of street that embraces multiplicity?

Furthermore, how do these walls contribute as part of public realm, to facilitate an interactive community between school and the neighbourhood?



02 REVIEWING PARAMETERS OF A 'WALL'



1. THICKNESS

'Body of the building has a crust, a zone where inside and outside meet, a zone of contradiction. This is where qualities of experience tip over into each other or out of each other, it especially is a fixed point of our experience of space. This zone might by called the 'conversational zone' of the architectonic language, in which the demands of environment are accepted or rejected...'

DETAILS - Curtain Mechanisms -













Solar heat gain: To prevent getting the interlayer space over-heated 1. wiremesh helps to reduce solar heat gain. 2. SIP panels are used to give insulation as well as structural support for light-weight roof construction.

1. TRANSFORMABLE THRESHOLD

Mesh crutain is opened. People access the church through the covered shed, where booths are placed for interaction before and after



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2. EVENT HALL TO PUBLIC

Mesh crutain is opened. The school has organized a ceremony where people in the neighbourhood are welcome to join.

3. REVEALLING THE LEVELLING

Unfolding the polycarbonate panels, the steps to the raised gallery space is revealed, differentiating itself from the normal street level during schooltime.







With mesh curtain closed & polycarbonate panels unfolded, half of the gallery is externalized to hold an outdoor workshop for the neighbourhood.



While solid wall is primarily built for security, the urban curtain is built to **activate urban life** around it.





Moments of Ephemeral Beauty and Happiness







THE SHADOW

Walking along the school boundary, the kid notices the pattern and texture of shadow, making his journey a game to walk according to the rhythmic map of shadow.







THE SUSPENDED

Lifted up from the ground, the segmented panels invite the sunlight to flow through its gaps. Drops of sunlight are spilled onto the cobble stones, making the panels look even lighter and thinner than they are.







THE SEAMS

Her eyes of wonder scan through the curtain and land on the glowing seams, which allow a peek into the outside world, that is usually masked by a solid construction of fear and anxiety.







THE TOUCHED

She touches the fence, feeling coldness and stiffness running at her fingertips; She touches the curtain, feeling the impact of her fingers performing as the resilience of the wire mesh.



04 REFLECTION: THE 'WAND-NESS' OF WALL









beutifying the school wall

rethinking the performative value of a 'wall'

Unlocked by 'wand-ness' of wall, evoking the search of **meaningfulness** and **integration.**

From a site of separation, to a site of integration



By operating each layer of curtain, the various actors would explore their own interpretation of this ambiguous seam



A currtain that has different meanings to public and school, and they co-exist.

A type of co-operated security



Within this narrow seam between school and street, is an unobvious yet sensitive testing ground that embodies how architect could craft capacity for an **equivocal built environment.**
