? FUTURE OF THE VILLAGE?

Strenghtening bond between remaining rural communities & providing opportunities for wider implementation of local skills to ensure exisiting communities can continute to operate their buisnesses

Changing perception of the rural

changing perception of the countryside in both the eyes of urban and rural communities to strenghten its image as cultural centre rather than 'land bank'

Countryside as idea initiator, with respect for local heritage & continuity of community - reviving rural areas and bringing new function to allow for accommodation of both rural and urban social group needs

Maximizing use of existing plots

to avoid expansion of village boundary in uncontrolled way (currently not regulated for 'ding' houses) and its spillage onto the conservation areas
