


The Path through the Area of Rogoredo












THE ARRIVAL

Potential landmarks - Abandoned sites - existing industries.




Rogoredo Train station
















From South to North




The urban void and the local industries at the back, on the North side of Rogoredo









Scalo Rogoredo is one of the seven railways which frame the city of Milan. Over the last decades the Italian railway company and the municipality of Milan have collaborated to convert all the seven Scalos from its unused transport function to edible construction site. Many of the other Scalo's have already been part of masterplan while the area of Rogoredo has been put on hold in the priority list of Milan. This signs a great opportunity for an intervention.




The emptyness of the area and its infrastructural potential is a huge opportunity to deal with high capacity of flow. At the back the area of the Scalo Ferroviario continues for the length of 1km, throughout the site.

Industries and the character of the North side of Rogoredo. This area is populated by many industrial related business that can contribute to the function, logistics and supply of the Event driven project.










