

Historically, most people lived in rural areas. However, Since ~2007, most people worldwide live in cities


>> Urban issues are more important than ever before and will continue to become more important in the future.




By ~2100, more than two-thirds of people worldwide will live in cities

Design assignment & conceptual framework



- Design centred around the **relief of urban stress** in **vulnerable neighbourhoods**, with people with a **low socioeconomic status** as the main **target group**
- End goal: **improve** the **health** of the target group
- **Overvecht** as a **case study**, approach will be **transferable** to and **applicable** in **other vulnerable neighbourhoods** with similar circumstances

Research question


What **spatial design** elements can improve the **health** of residents of **vulnerable neighbourhoods** with a **low socioeconomic status** through **stress-relief**,
based on the case study of **Overvecht, Utrecht?**

“Perfect health is a state of complete **physical, mental, and social wellbeing** and **not** merely an **absence of disease or infirmity**”




“A state of **bodily or mental tension** developed through **city living...**”

“Urban stress is the **cumulative stress** caused by the experience of **living in unfavorable conditions of the urban environment** (...) and if these conditions are **beyond the urbanite's tolerance**, he will experience **urban stress**”



Overall urban stress

- Unclear collective spaces
 - ↔ Lack of access to greenery
 - Repetition
 - Lack of safe cycling network
 - High speed roads (50+ km/h)
 - Houses with low energy label
 - Worst nuisance and unsafety
 - ▣ Most trouble making ends meet
 - Nitrogen pollution
 - Light pollution
 - Noise pollution due to traffic (cars and trains)
 - Roads busy during commuting
 - ▣ Possible smell pollution
- Heat island effect**
- 1,2-1,4 degrees Celsius
 - 1,4-1,6 degrees Celsius
 - 1,6-1,8 degrees Celsius
 - 1,8-2,0 degrees Celsius
 - 2,0+ degrees Celsius



SWOT analysis


Weaknesses not mapped:

- Lack of public seats/social furniture




Neighbourhood design

- Added functions to buildings (dead plinths)
- Added functions to outside spaces
- Increase in natural features & biodiversity
- Changes to car network, cycling network, public transport network, pedestrian network







Mobility (A): Car and car-alternatives




- One-way roads where possible & suitable
- Added parking to relieve parking pressure from street



- Bus re-routed through neighbourhood & added bus stop in park (with bus trap)
- Expanded cycling network through neighbourhood & park
- Increased connectivity through long buildings


