Drawing observations:

- Trees with enormous tree trunks and small treetops
- Drawings are usually drawn in elevation/section
- Using or mentioning a building or man-made space as an anchor for a specific nature memory
- A surprisingly good awareness of nature's meaning
- Excitement surrounding the subject and increase in longing to visit nature after the workshop

CLASS 4/5/6
AGE RANGE: 7-10 YEARS OLD

Drawing observations:

- Trees, flowers, and grass as recurring themes, but quite an absence of animals
- The drawings are usually drawn in elevation/section. Grass below, sky above
- Inability/lack of confidence to draw nature
- Weather (rain) as recurring theme
- Flowers were names first when answering the question in most drawing processes
- Enthusiasm and excitement about the workshop itself, rather than excitement surrounding the subject
